

Reflections for the week

It seems that the confusion of many Christians today is because they have forgotten or do not even recognize their dignity and the gift they received in Baptism. Most parents who prepare for their children's baptism remember from catechesis that baptism wipes away original sin.

However, few of them are already aware of the gift of new life that the baptized are part of. Baptism is much more than a sign of conversion and penance, it is a radically new life in Christ. Consequently, both the parents and the baptized child, as he or she grows up, are responsible for nurturing this life. Failure to do so may lead to the danger that the baptism will be treated as a one-off, somewhat magical event without deeper consequences. Meanwhile, it is a saving event that is constantly being carried out in our lives. Let us remember that the grace of Holy Baptism is renewed in us every time we approach the sacrament of reconciliation, we devoutly participate in the Eucharist, do penance and works of mercy. It is the realization of this fact that becomes the foundation of our relationship with God and the constant discovery of His inexhaustible love for us - converting sinners, redeemed by His precious blood.
