### **SPONSOR CERTIFICATE AND LETTER OF GOOD STANDING**

The purpose of a sponsor certificate is for the individual (sponsor) to aid the candidate in leading a Christian life in a manner that faithfully fulfills the obligations of Catholic faith. To do this, the individual must be living the Catholic faith. The certificate is a sworn statement that attest you are actively attending mass, practice the catholic faith, and have received Baptism, First Communion and Confirmation. Therefore, if you are not a registered parishioner of this this parish, you will not be able to be a sponsor. If you wish to become a parishioner, then you must register and wait a three-month period before we give you the certificate. Completing the Sacraments in this parish does not qualify you to receive a sponsor certificate.

## Our Lady of Mount Carmel - July 16

Hermits lived on Mount Carmel near the Fountain of Elijah in northern Israel in the 12th century. They had a chapel dedicated to Our Lady. By the 13th century they became known as “Brothers of Our Lady of Mount Carmel.” They soon celebrated a special Mass and Office in honor of Mary. In 1726, it became a celebration of the universal Church under the title of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. For centuries the Carmelites have seen themselves as specially related to Mary. Their great saints and theologians have promoted devotion to her and often championed the mystery of her Immaculate Conception. Saint Teresa of Avila called Carmel “the Order of the Virgin.” Saint John of the Cross credited Mary with saving him from drowning as a child, leading him to Carmel, and helping him escape from prison. Saint Thérèse of the Child Jesus believed that Mary cured her from illness. On her First Communion day, Thérèse dedicated her life to Mary. During the last days of her life she frequently spoke of Mary. There is a tradition—which may not be historical—that Mary appeared to Saint Simon Stock, a leader of the Carmelites, and gave him a scapular, telling him to promote devotion to it. The scapular is a modified version of Mary’s own garment. It symbolizes her special protection and calls the wearers to consecrate themselves to her in a special way. The scapular reminds us of the gospel call to prayer and penance—a call that Mary models in a splendid way.

## *Reflections for the week*

The disciples whom the Lord sends to proclaim what they have seen and learned from the Master are to remember that the power to cast out evil spirits and heal the sick is not their natural feature. It is first and foremost and exclusively a gift received at the moment of their vocation. I think we often forget this truth as 21st century disciples. Whatever we have in life, we have all received from God first. St. Paul the Apostle understood this truth very well when he says that we should exist for the praise of His majesty, as gifted with numerous privileges by God in Christ Jesus. We are all called like the prophet Amos to go to loved ones and to strangers. We ought to bring hope of life in freedom and dignity. This is what our growth in holiness for the praise and glory of God is all about. Namely to accept our own calling while actively affirming those whom God sends to us and those to whom we are sent. So how do I live my vocation? How do I relate to difficulties that discourage me from sharing my faith? Finally, how do I relate to those who don't want to hear God's word at all?

Przyjąć własne powołanie, jednocześnie czynnie afirmując tych, których Bóg posyła do nas, i tych, do których my jesteśmy posłani.

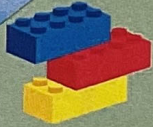

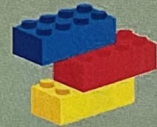
