SPONSOR CERTIFICATE AND LETTER OF GOOD STANDING

The purpose of a sponsor certificate is for the individual (sponsor) to aid the candidate in leading a Christian life in a manner that faithfully fulfills the obligations of Catholic faith. To do this, the individual must be living the Catholic faith. The certificate is a sworn statement that attest you are actively attending mass, practice the catholic faith, and have received Baptism, First Communion and Confirmation. Therefore, if you are not a registered parishioner of this this parish, you will not be able to be a sponsor. If you wish to become a parishioner, then you must register and wait a three-month period before we give you the certificate. Completing the Sacraments in this parish does not qualify you to receive a sponsor certificate.

Reflections for the week

"Daughter, your faith has saved you"

Jesus spoke these words to a woman healed of a hemorrhage. The healing took place without his knowledge - the power came from him. Jesus always said to the healed, "Your faith has healed you." We often ask: Why are there so few miracles today? Are we sure of this? People are looking for miracles as the extraordinary interference of God. They, even if they are witnesses of a miracle, usually do not notice it. For those who live their lives full of faith, miracles are almost daily bread. People of faith recognize God's action also in various ordinary events, even those that can be explained from the point of view of science.

Fr. Jacek Salij, OP, in the book "Looking for a Way" wrote: "What is a miracle for a believer? A believer is constantly turning in a circle of miracles. The same matter, which we all touch, weigh, measure and use, is illuminated by the light of God, invisible to nonspiritual people, but only in this light reveals its extraordinary magnificence. It is only in this light that we can experience that God's Providence embraces literally every moment of our life that God takes care of us completely. Even the sickness, suffering and persecution that affect all people are permeated by the power of God, but the unbelievers are locked up to them. Every detail of our life - good and bad - has its roots in the invisible world, and only when we see it we go in that direction, we begin to understand how wonderful our life is and the world in which we live." It is faith that gives meaning to our lives, we open ourselves to God by faith and through faith, God can come to us. Sometimes you have to trust Him, even our mind and other people say something different, just like relatives said to Jairus: Don't disturb the Master, your daughter has already died. What does Jesus say then to Jairus? "Do not be afraid just believe!"

Refleksja na tydzień

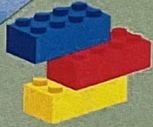
„Córko, twoja wiara cię ocaliła”

Te słowa Jezus wypowiedział do kobiety uzdrowionej z krwotoku. Uzdrawienie dokonało się niejako bez Jego wiedzy - moc wyszła z Niego. Jezus zawsze mówił do uzdrowionych „twoja wiara cię uzdrowiła”. Ludzie często pytają: Dlaczego dzisiaj tak mało cudów? Czy aby napewno? Ludzie nie tyle szukają cudów co raczej nadzwyczajnej ingerencji Boga. Oni, nawet jeśli są świadkami cudu, to przeważnie go nie zauważają. Dlatego jednak, kto żyje pełnią wiary, cuda są niemal chlebem powszednim. Człowiek wiary rozpoznaje działanie Boga również w rozmaitych zwykłych wydarzeniach, nawet tych wytłumaczalnych z punktu widzenia nauki. Ojciec Jacek Salij OP w książce Szukający drogi pisał: „Czym jest cud dla człowieka wierzącego? Człowiek wierzący nieustannie obraca się w kręgu cudów. Ta sama materia, którą wszyscy dotykamy, ważymy, mierzymy i używamy, jest przeświecona światłem Bożym, niewidzialnym jednak dla ludzi nieduchowych, ale dopiero w tym świetle ujawnia swoją niezwykłą wspaniałość. Dopiero w tym świetle możemy doświadczyć, że Boża Opatrzność ogarnia dosłownie każdą chwilę naszego życia, że Najlepszy Ojciec opiekuje się nami bez reszty. Nawet choroby, cierpienia i prześladowania, którym na równi podlegają wszyscy ludzie, są przeniknięte mocą Bożą, na którą ludzie nieduchowi są zamknięci. Każdy szczegół naszego życia – dobry i zły – ma swoje korzenie w świecie niewidzialnym i dopiero kiedy to widzimy i w tamtym kierunku poszukujemy, zaczynamy rozumieć, jak cudowne jest życie i świat, w którym żyjemy.” To wiara nadaje sens naszemu życiu, przez wiarę otwieramy się na Boga a przez to On może przyjść do nas. Czasami trzeba Mu zaufać mimo, że rozum i inni ludzie mówią coś innego, tak jak bliscy Jaira: Nie męcz już Mistrza, twoja córka już umarła. Co Jezus mówi wówczas do Jaira? „Nie bój się tylko wierz”!

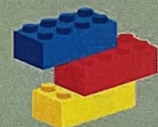
