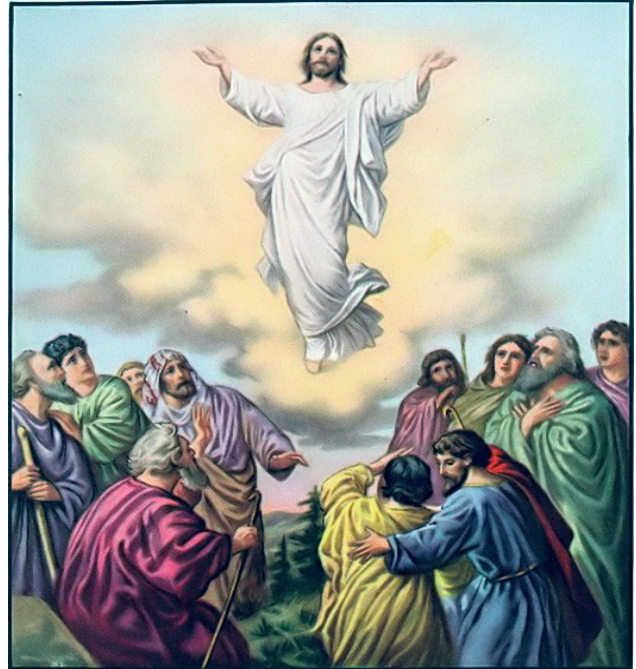

SPONSOR CERTIFICATE AND LETTER OF GOOD STANDING

The purpose of a sponsor certificate is for the individual (sponsor) to aid the candidate in leading a Christian life in a manner that faithfully fulfills the obligations of Catholic faith. To do this, the individual must be living the Catholic faith. The certificate is a sworn statement that attest you are actively attending mass, practice the catholic faith, and have received Baptism, First Communion and Confirmation. Therefore, if you are not a registered parishioner of this this parish, you will not be able to be a sponsor. If you wish to become a parishioner, then you must register and wait a three-month period before we give you the certificate. Completing the Sacraments in this parish does not qualify you to receive a sponsor certificate.

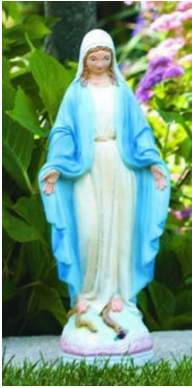

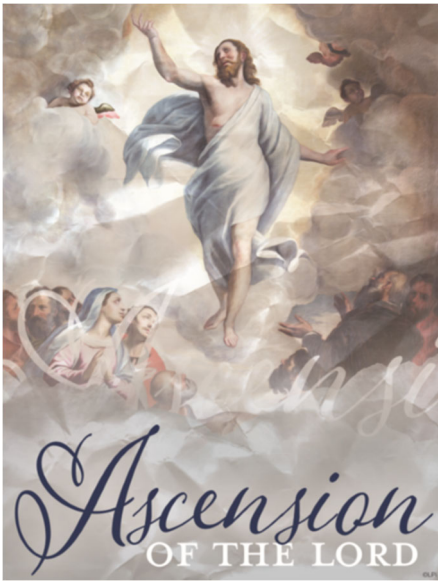

Reflections for the week



Today, the Holy Mother Church is celebrating the Ascension of the Lord. On this day I would like to stimulate our hearts and minds to prayerful reflection related to this event. I will use the official document of the Church, which is the Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC). We read in it that the Ascension of Christ determines the final entry of Jesus' humanity into the heavenly reign of God, from where he will return, which, however, currently hides Him from the sight of people. Article 661 says, among other things: „...Left to its own natural powers humanity does not have access to the "Father's house", to God's life and happiness. Only Christ can open to man such access...". Jesus Christ, Head of the Church, precedes us in the glorious Kingdom of the Father, that we, as members of His Body, may live in the hope that one day we will be with Him forever. After entering the sanctuary of heaven once and for all, he constantly intercedes for us as a Mediator who constantly gives us the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Our Lord, as we believe and confess, will come from there again to judge the living and the dead. We read in article 673 of the CCC: "Since the Ascension Christ's coming in glory has been imminent, even though "it is not for you to know times or seasons which the Father has fixed by his own authority". This eschatological coming could be accomplished at any moment, even if both it and the final trial that will precede it are "delayed". Consequently, we read in article 675: "Before Christ's second coming the Church must pass through a final trial that will shake the faith of many believers. The persecution that accompanies her pilgrimage on earth will unveil the "mystery of iniquity" in the form of a religious deception offering men an apparent solution to their problems at the price of apostasy from the truth. The supreme religious deception is that of the Antichrist, a pseudo-messianism by which man glorifies himself in place of God and of his Messiah come in the flesh." I would like to conclude today's reflection by quoting from articles 678 and 679 of the CCC: "Following in the steps of the prophets and John the Baptist, Jesus announced the judgment of the Last Day in His preaching. Then will the conduct of each one and the secrets of hearts be brought to light. Then will the culpable unbelief that counted the offer of God's grace as nothing be condemned. Our attitude to our neighbor will disclose acceptance or refusal of grace and divine love. On the Last Day Jesus will say: "Truly I say to you, as you did it to one of the least of these my brethren, you did it to me." Christ is Lord of eternal life. Full right to pass definitive judgment on the works and hearts of men belongs to Him as redeemer of the world. He "acquired" this right by His cross. The Father has given "all judgment to the Son". Yet the Son did not come to judge, but to save and to give the life He has in himself. By rejecting grace in this life, one already judges oneself, receives according to one's works, and can even condemn oneself for all eternity by rejecting the Spirit of love." Let us remember then that there are truths in this world that do not change. The wise Carthusian motto says that the world is spinning, and the cross is standing. Cross stands and will stand until the end. Let us persistently seek the truth, because only it will set us free. It is not like many false prophets are trying today to convince us that everything in life is runny. Christ and His teaching is changeless! And we must remember that. Through our perseverance, we will save our souls.



Refleksja na tydzień

W dniu dzisiejszym święta Matka Kościół obchodzi uroczystość Wniebowstąpienia Pana Jezusa. Chciałbym w tym dniu pobudzić nasze serca i umysły do modlitewnej refleksji związanej z tym wydarzeniem. Posłużę się w tym celu oficjalnym dokumentem Kościoła, jakim jest Katechizm Kościoła

Katolickiego. Czytamy w nim, że Wniebowstąpienie Chrystusa określa ostateczne wejście człowieczeństwa Jezusa do niebieskiego panowania Boga, skąd kiedyś powróci, które jednak obecnie zakrywa Go przed wzrokiem ludzi. Numer 661 mówi między innymi: „...Człowieczeństwo pozostawione swoim własnym siłom nie ma dostępu do „domu Ojca”, do życia i do szczęścia Bożego. Jedynie Chrystus mógł otworzyć człowiekowi taki dostęp...”. Jezus Chrystus, Głowa Kościoła, poprzedza nas w chwalebnym Królestwie Ojca, abyśmy jako członki Jego Ciała żyli w nadziei, że pewnego dnia będziemy z Nim na wieki. Po swoim wejściu raz na zawsze do sanktuarium niebieskiego wstawia się nieustannie za nami jako Pośrednik, który zapewnia nam nieustannie wylanie Ducha Świętego. Nasz Pan jak wierzymy i wyznajemy przyjdzie stamtąd powtórnie, aby sądzić żywych i umarłych. W numerze 673 KKK czytamy: „Od Wniebowstąpienia przyjdzie Chrystusa w chwale jest bliskie, nawet jeśli nie do nas należy „znać czasy i chwile, które Ojciec ustalił swoją władzą”. Przyjście eschatologiczne może wypełnić się w każdej chwili, nawet jeśli to przyjdzie i ostateczna próba, która je poprzedzi, są jeszcze „zatrzymane”. Konsekwentnie w numerze 675 czytamy: „Przed przyjściem Chrystusa Kościół ma przejść przez końcową próbę, która zachwieje wiarą wielu wierzących. Prześladowanie, które towarzyszy jego pielgrzymce przez ziemię, odsłoni „tajemnicę bezbożności” pod postacią oszukańczej religii, dającej ludziom pozorne rozwiązanie ich problemów za cenę odstępstwa od prawdy. Największym oszustwem religijnym jest oszustwo Antychrysta, czyli oszustwo pseudomesjanizmu, w którym człowiek uwielbia samego siebie zamiast Boga i Jego Mesjasza, który przyszedł w ciele”. Pragnę zakończyć dzisiejszą refleksję cytatem z numerów 678 i 679 KKK: „...W ślad za prorokami i Janem Chrzcicielem Jezus zapowiedział w swoim przepowiadaniu sąd, który nastąpi w dniu ostatecznym. Zostanie wtedy ujawnione postępowanie każdego człowieka i wyjdą na jaw tajemnice serc. Nastąpi wtedy potępienie zwinionej niewiary, która lekceważyła łaskę ofiarowaną przez Boga. Postawa wobec bliźniego objawi przyjęcie lub odrzucenie łaski i miłości Bożej. Jezus powie w dniu ostatecznym: „Wszystko, co uczyniliście jednemu z tych braci moich najmniejszych, Mnieście uczynili.” Chrystus jest Panem życia wiecznego. Do Niego jako do Odkupiciela świata należy pełne prawo ostatecznego osądzenia czynów i serc ludzi. „Nabył” On to prawo przez swój Krzyż. W taki sposób Ojciec „cały sąd przekazał Synowi”. Syn jednak nie przyszedł, by sądzić, ale by zbawić i dać życie, które jest w Nim. Przez odrzucenie łaski w tym życiu każdy osądza już samego siebie, otrzymuje według swoich uczynków i może nawet potępić się na wieczność, odrzucając Ducha miłości”. Pamiętajmy zatem, że są w tym świecie prawdy, które się nie zmieniają. Mądre kartuskie motto mówi, że świat się kręci, a krzyż stoi. Stoi i będzie stał, aż do końca. Szukajmy zatem wytrwale Prawdy, bo tylko ona nas wyzwoli. Nie jest bowiem tak, jak wielu fałszywych proroków próbuje dzisiaj nam wmówić, że wszystko w życiu jest płynne. Chrystus i Jego nauka jest niezmienna! I trzeba nam o tym pamiętać. Przez wytrwałość bowiem ocalimy nasze dusze.
