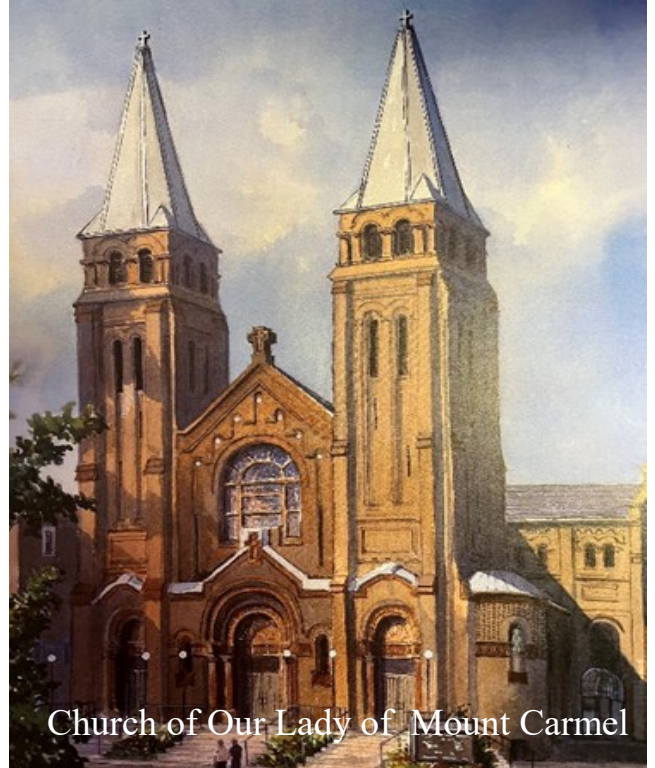

It is a great tragedy and our failure to judge others through the prism of what you have, what you look like or what your position in society is. St. James in his letter, very strict and demanding in its content, warns Christians against introducing world standards within the community and reminds them of God's love of poverty. *Anawim*, or the poor in spirit, are those who, having no material or other security, base their entire existence solely on trust and trust in God.

God chose and was pleased with the poor of this world. Love, therefore, excludes favoring the rich and privileged in any way and any contempt for the poor.

We should never forget this.

Certificates of Eligibility to Become a Godparent
