



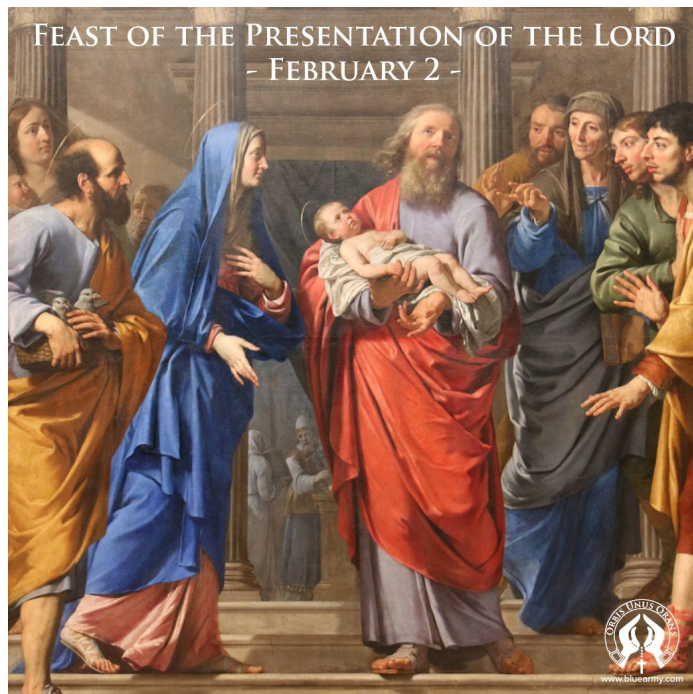

ANNUAL ²⁰²⁵ APPEAL

The Annual Archdiocesan Service for the Week of Prayer (18--25 January) for Christian Unity

Will take place in our St. John Paul II Parish on Sunday, February 2, 2025, at 3:00 pm Sponsored by the Ecumenical Commission of the Archdiocese.

The Most Reverend Gregory Studerus, the Regional Bishop for Hudson County, will preside at this Ecumenical Celebration of the Word of God. There will be a guest preacher, The Reverend Lynne Bleich Weber, rector of the Church of the Atonement in Tenafly and Ecumenical and Interreligious officer for the Episcopal Diocese of Newark. The choir of St. Mary of the Immaculate Conception Church, Newark, will provide music and a reception will follow in the Church Hall.

Everyone interested in praying with our Lord Jesus Christ for the Unity of his disciples is warmly invited to attend.

It is interesting to note that St. John Paul II is the only pope to have written an encyclical letter about ecumenism and its importance in the life and mission of the Church: "Ut Unum sint"1999.

This Holy Year 2025 (" Pilgrims of Hope") observance of the Week of Prayer has as its theme: " Do you believe?" (John 11:26) taken from the account of the raising of Lazarus. This is especially timely since this same year will be marked by the celebration of a common Easter in both East and West and by the 1700th centenary of the first Ecumenical Council of Nicaea and the Creed it established.
