

CURRICULUM

The current National Curriculum for England has been in place since September 2014. It's a set of subjects and standards for all maintained schools in England to follow, ensuring that children throughout the country learn the same things. The National Curriculum is designed to be 'balanced and broadly based.'

The aim is to promote the spiritual, moral, cultural, mental, and physical development of pupils and prepare them for the opportunities, responsibilities, and experiences of later life. The school's curriculum is based on the national curriculum of England, although as an independent school, other disciplines, such as Basic Latin and Islamic Studies, are added as distinctive characteristics of the school.

The Daffodil Prep set curriculum is for Key Stage 1 (Years 1 and 2) and Key Stage 2 (Years 3-6). Key Stage 2 is split into lower Key Stage 2 (Years 3 and 4) and upper Key Stage 2 (Years 5 and 6).

ENGLISH

Curriculum Outline: The English curriculum at Daffodil Preparatory School encompasses a wide range of language skills, including reading, writing, speaking, and listening. Students will engage with various literary texts, explore different writing styles, and develop effective communication skills.

KS1 Coverage: In Key Stage 1 (KS1), students will focus on foundational literacy skills. They will learn phonics to decode words, develop basic grammar and punctuation knowledge, and explore different types of texts such as narratives, poetry, and non-fiction. Reading comprehension activities will enhance their understanding of texts, while creative writing tasks will encourage imaginative expression.

KS2 Coverage: Key Stage 2 (KS2) builds upon the skills developed in KS1 and introduces more complex literary concepts. Students will delve deeper into comprehension strategies, analyse texts for meaning and structure, and refine their writing style across various genres. They will also explore elements of literary devices, language conventions, and critical thinking to become proficient communicators and insightful readers.



MATHEMATICS

Curriculum Outline: The Maths curriculum at Daffodil Preparatory School is designed to develop students' mathematical fluency, problem-solving skills, and logical reasoning abilities. It covers key areas such as number sense, geometry, measurement, statistics, and algebra.

KS1 Coverage: In Key Stage 1 (KS1), students will focus on building a strong foundation in numeracy. They will learn to count, recognise numbers, and understand basic mathematical operations such as addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division. They will also explore simple shapes, patterns, and measurement concepts through hands-on activities and practical tasks.

Students will explore fractions, decimals, percentages, geometry, and algebraic equations. They will also develop problem-solving strategies, mathematical reasoning skills, and the ability to apply mathematical concepts to real-life situations.

SCIENCE

Curriculum Outline: The Science curriculum at Daffodil Preparatory School aims to build curiosity, critical thinking, and scientific inquiry skills. It covers key scientific concepts across disciplines such as Biology, Chemistry, Physics, and earth sciences.

KS1 Coverage: In Key Stage 1 (KS1), students will develop basic computer skills such as using digital devices, navigating software applications, and understanding internet safety. They will also engage in simple coding activities and explore design concepts through hands-on DT projects.

KS2 Coverage: Key Stage 2 (KS2) expands upon the computational and design skills introduced in KS1. Students will learn programming concepts, develop their understanding and explore digital creativity through multimedia projects. They will also engage in practical DT tasks such as prototyping and construction.



LANGUAGES

Curriculum Outline: The Languages curriculum at Daffodil Preparatory School introduces students to the richness of language and culture, building communication skills and intercultural understanding. Students may have the opportunity to learn languages such as French, Spanish, or Arabic.

KS1 Coverage: In Key Stage 1 (KS1), students will be introduced to basic vocabulary, phrases, and expressions in the target language. HISTORY

LITERACY AND NUMERACY

At Daffodil Prep, we ensure a strong foundation in literacy and numeracy through personalised instruction and engaging activities. Our approach to literacy includes phonics instruction for early readers, comprehension strategies, and diverse writing opportunities. Similarly, in numeracy, we focus on building number sense, problem-solving skills, and mathematical reasoning. Through hands-on activities, small group work, and tailored support, we ensure that every student masters essential literacy and numeracy skills, setting them up for academic success and lifelong learning.

BASIC LATIN

All Daffodil pupils will have a rare opportunity to study basic Latin early on in their learning journey. This is an important distinctive characteristic of Daffodil Prep School. Latin is the mother of many languages. It may not be spoken anymore but yet forms the root of modern languages such as, English, Spanish, Italian and Portuguese. Learning Latin therefore, enhances the learner's ability to acquire skills in many other languages and can therefore translate other languages into English. This will enhance the learner's understanding of the grammar of the English language and therefore become capable of translating between English and another language. Although Latin may not be a spoken language, it is not dead, as it can be seen used across a myriad of modern professional texts and axioms in Law and concepts in science and technology.



ISLAMIC STUDIES & QURAN

At Daffodil Prep, our Quran and Qa'idah curriculum extends beyond mere recitation, encompassing an inclusive approach to spiritual development. Alongside mastering Tajiweed rules, application of Makharij, and Arabic proficiency, students are immersed in the practice of Du'as (supplications) and other Adhkar (remembrances), cultivating a habit of mindfulness and connection to their faith throughout their day.

Moreover, we encourage congregational Salah (prayer) times, providing students with opportunities to pray together in a supportive and nurturing environment. Through regular Salah sessions, students not only strengthen their spiritual connection but also create a sense of community and brotherhood/sistenhood. Alongside this, students will be taught the colourful stories of our beloved Prophets, Sahabahs and other notable figures; bringing history and Hadith to life and encouraging them to follow the teachings of those before us.

Additionally, students are taught the importance of Wudu (ablution) and its significance in preparing for Salah, instilling in them the value of cleanliness and ritual purity. By integrating Wudu practices into their daily routine, students develop positive habits and discipline that extend beyond the classroom, creating a sense of responsibility and commitment to their faith.

Through a comprehensive approach to Quranic education, coupled with the practice of Du'as, congregational Salah, and Hadith, students at Daffodil Prep not only excel academically but also emerge as spiritually grounded individuals equipped with the knowledge and values to navigate the challenges of the modern world with faith and integrity.

At Daffodil Prep, we believe in creating a comprehensive Islamic education for our students. Alongside their academic curriculum, we encourage students to dedicate time to memorising the Quran, mastering the Arabic language, and studying Fiqh (Islamic jurisprudence). At Daffodil Preparatory School, our code of conduct serves as a guide for all members of the school community, promoting a culture of respect, integrity, and excellence in all endeavours.


