## Course/Program: COMPUTER SERVICES TECHNICIAN (English/Spanish)

## Objective:

This program has been designed to prepare students in the field of computer repair, focusing on identification, installation, assembling, configuration, function, and computer operation. It involves the study of personal computer hardware and operating systems. This class is presented with both lecture and lab portions. Students are expected to attend all classes since hands-on lab-based work is essential. Students will be assigned approximately 6 quizzes during the duration of the program to evaluate progress and diploma candidacy, including lab participation. Two of those quizzes are included in an introductory class, which is part of this program and can be as long as 4 months, depending on the student's progress. In the event a student does not pass the assigned exams, the student may receive a certificate for the number of hours completed in the program, at the instructor's discretion. \*Students will receive a certificate upon completion of the training program.

**Potential Occupations after Completion**: Students will be able to seek entry-level positions on job occupation – Computer Services professionals installing, maintaining, customizing, and operation of personal computers. Job title – Computer Services Technician and IT Specialist.
