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Course/Program: Objective:

GRAPHIC DESIGN WINDOWS ONLINE (English/Spanish)

This course is an online working studio class that is intended to teach students how to combine images and text skillfully. Through demonstrations and hands-on work, students will learn to solve visual problems using Adobe Photoshop, Illustrator and InDesign.

Assignments and other projects will be assigned periodically to help support and supplement material covered in class lessons. There are six 48-hour modules in this course. To complete this course and receive a certificate, students must pass the test given after each module with a grade of "C" or better. No internship or externship is required.

Students will receive a certificate upon successful completion of the training program. Successful completion of the training program consists of passing the test with a "C" or better after each module.

Potential Occupations after Completion: Students will be able to seek entry-level positions on job occupation - Working in the printing shop, school, artist, teacher. Job title – Graphic Designer, Assistant Graphic Designer, Freelance Web Designer.

The job classification this program prepares its graduates for using the United States Department of Labor's Standard Occupational Classification codes, at Detailed Occupational (six-digit) level are 27-1024 Graphic Designers, 27-4032 Film and Video Editors, 27-4090 Miscellaneous Media and Communication Equipment Workers, and 15-1255 Web and Digital Interface Designers.
