- Vest orders (Antonio Ledezma) Ordered and waiting for an update from the vendor.
- Form 990 Has this been filed? Not yet
- Deacon Bill's estate sale went well. The Catholic Daughters made \$4000.

New Business

- Perpetual Memorial Society Plague has been ordered for Walt Galegan.
- Jim B proposed that the monthly breakfast be provided at no charge while accepting free will donations, and put the donations to a given cause.
- Chris L. made a motion to have breakfast for a donation. Will Stanley 2nd.
 - Chris stated that the breakfast should be for socialization not profit.
 - Antonio L. asked if we are making each breakfast for a specific cause or at the Grand Knight's discretion?
 - The original motion was called for a vote and passed.
- Jim B proposed that the council consider giving a monthly defined donation to the food pantry.
- Jim B made a motion that the council provide assistance to Jerry Cisneros with house and yard repair. Up to \$250 for materials from the council. The motion was seconded by Antonio L. A committee will be created to set the date. Motion was called to vote and unanimously approved.
- Jim B asked for discussion on whether to cater the memorial dinner or keep it potluck. No motion was made.
- Rumaldo Cisneros proposed that the council bring back the Keep Christ in Christmas campaign.
 - Antonio L made a motion to buy yard signs and Christmas cards with bingo funds and give them away, not to exceed the budgeted amount funded by Bingo. Rumaldo seconded. The motion passed.
- Jim Leonard offered thanks to Caesar for cleaning the upstairs kitchen in the hall. He suggested that the council consider whether hiring a professional cleaner for the upstairs would be appropriate, and/or have a council cleanup day.
- Antonio L made a motion to pay Caesar Espinoza \$100 for cleaning the kitchen. Rumaldo seconded the motion. The motion passed with no audible dissent.
