• Unfinished Business was taken up and disposed of as follows:

- Form 990 Status? Antonio Ledezma is working on this.
- Semi-Annual audit is past due. Trustees are completing
- Check to food pantry for December Breakfast?
- Dinner with priests St Augustine is replacing the operating portion of the HVAC system. Expected to cost \$80,000. Fr. Julio asked the Council to host a dinner to raise \$10,000.
 - GK discussed possible dates with Fr. Julio. His first choice is Fat Tuesday (5:00-8:00). His second choice is Sunday March 2nd (5:00-8:00). If Tuesday, he needs Knights to set up, serve and clean (he did not ask for us to pay for food, but request is likely to happen), he has a chef available for Tuesday. If Sunday, needs Knights to set up, cook, serve, clean and pay.
 - Possible dinner if we cook: smoke 5 or 6 briskets and pork shoulders
 - Need to approve budget, discussed previous Dinner with the Priest details, including inviting Catholic Daughters to help again
 - \$50 donation to get a ticket to dinner, additional donation beyond \$50 to be considered for sitting with the priest; highest extra donation. Possibly budget of \$1,500.
 - Jim Leonard motions that we provide a total of \$5,000 going toward the Dinner with Priest, \$2,000 to be allocated for food, beer, wine, dessert, etc. Cesar Espinoza second. Discussion involved \$5,000 to be at the ready to backfill the goal, with \$2,000 still being allocated for food, beer, win, dessert, etc. so a total of \$7,000 might be more accurate to ensure a successful fundraising.
 - Rumaldo Cisneros moves to make amendment:
 - 1. With the goal of raising \$5,000 for St. Augustine to support upgrades and/or repairs to the HVAC system, Council 3285 will supplement, in an amount not to exceed \$5,000, all dinner ticket sales and donations for the dinner that sum to less than \$5,000 to ensure St. Augustine's receives \$5,000.
 - 2. Council 3285 will contribute up to \$1,500 to support the cost of the food for the dinner.
 - 3. Up to \$500 approved for expenses of supporting the dinner.

Expense approvals total up to \$7,000.

• Jim Leonard accepts amendment and Cesar Espinoza accepts amendment. With no further discussion, Intent to Vote will be sent to Council to be voted on at a later date.
