2024 Northglenn Elks House Rules

The following "House Rules" have been reviewed and adopted by the official governing body of the "Club" - to wit - "House Committee;" per Northglenn B.P.O.Elks No. 2438 By-Laws.

All portions of this facility shall be construed to be part of the "Club." To wit - Lounge, Dining Room, Game, Card and the Lodge Room when utilized as a part of the "Club."

The indulgence of each and every Member is requested, encouraged and will be greatly appreciated by all.

- 13. There is no limit as to the number of guests a Member may bring into the Club. However, on any occasion that might be deemed a "busy" time, any group of guests should be cleared with Club Manager in advance.
- 14. The bar shall be closed during all regular and special meetings of the Lodge; and all card carrying Elks not attending shall leave the building.
- 15. Children, under the age of sixteen (16), shall be under the control and direct supervision of their parents at all times while in the Club. (Control and direct supervision shall include any children infringing on the rights of others.) All children must be out of the Club by ten o'clock p.m. (10:00 p.m.) unless otherwise approved in advance by the House Committee.
- 16. Hats may not be worn on the Lodge floor at any time.
- 17. Only registered certified service dogs are permitted in the Club Room. Service dogs are not permitted in the kitchen or serving areas due to the health and hazard risks.
 - a.) A copy of the Americans with Disabilities Acts (ADA) will be kept at the bar.
- 18. All House Rules will be enforced. Infractions, thereof, will result in appropriate House Committee action.

All "House Rules" and unwritten policies are in basic compliance with Colorado State liquor codes and local laws, together with Grand Lodge Statutes and generally accepted Elks Lodge practices.

Dress Code - Currently there is no official "dress code" in place. Your discretion in appearance and appropriate dress will be greatly appreciated.

Adopted and approved according to Grand Lodge Statutes Section 17.060.

This is to certify that the amended and substituted By-Laws of **Northglenn, CO Lodge, No. 2438**, submitted online and approved by the designated member of the Grand Lodge Committee on Judiciary, were proposed at a regular meeting of the Lodge, in writing, held on **Thursday, June 15**, **2023**, read before the Lodge, and laid over until the regular meeting held on **Thursday, August 17**, **2023**, and at that regular meeting said amended and substituted By-Laws were adopted by a majority vote of all the members present.
