Secretary's Letter



Update from the Northglenn Elks on Coronavirus

As the coronavirus (COVID-19) situation continues to evolve, Our Lodge is proactively taking steps to protect and support our members, families and the community where we live and work. Our priority is to ensure the well-being of our Members and to minimize the risk of illness to those we love. As we continue to monitor the latest COVID-19 developments and the evolving impact of the virus, your health and safety remain our top priority.

After very thoughtful and thorough consideration, we have decided that it is in everyone's best interest that **starting Tuesday, March 17th, The Club and Restaurant Facilities** at the Northglenn Elks Lodge location will **shut down for a 30 day period.** This includes all Club related functions. The Offices will remain open with limited hours to ensure the needs of our members are addressed. We will continue to monitor events and will reevaluate after 14 days.

All scheduled events will be cancelled or postponed. While meetings remain on the calendar, they will be on an as needed basis and may be cancelled if not deemed necessary to the sustained operations of our Lodge.

We continue to monitor each day's events very closely. Our Leadership Team also continues to meet daily to discuss the situation and take action when necessary based on updates from the Center for Disease Control (CDC) and World Health Organization (WHO) as well as federal, state, and local agencies.

While we cannot speculate the course of the virus or anticipate the required actions these agencies must take, our goal is to return to normal operations on April 17th 2020. This date is very flexible. Please continue to monitor our facebook page and our web page for updated information. You can also call the Lodge weekday mornings to talk to the Secretary or Manager for additional information.

We recognize this is a time of uncertainty and greatly appreciate your patience and understanding as we work through this challenging situation. 
