

Did You Know????

Taken From Grand Lodge Statutes: Section 16.040

The Club shall be managed by one of three methods. The Lodge By-Laws will specify the option. Our managing body consists of the Exalted Ruler, Leading Knight, Loyal Knight, Lecturing Knight and the five Trustees. Some of the duties of the managing body (House Committee) include:

- This committee as a hole is responsible for the operations of the Club and Social Parlor of the Lodge.
- Present a budget to the Lodge Floor that must be voted on and approved by the last meeting in April each year.
- Responsible for purchasing and pricing of items to maintain complience with the approved annual budget
- Hold at least one meeting a month that is generally open to the membership with the exception of disciplinary discussion and actions.
- Closed sessions can be called for with a majority vote but should be used sparingly for employment, discipline and pricing of goods. Voting must be done in an open session.

Now, while I understand that in many of your hearts and minds it's hard to think of me as anything other than a sex symbol, for now, just consider me "essential personnel".



Celebrating our 50th Anniversary... Do You Remember?

Through the history of our Lodge, we have pulled together to overcome adversary when ever we are called upon to do so. Probably one of the most trying events we have experienced was the Fire June 28, 1975.

We had moved from East Lake to a warehouse location just east of Irma Drive on 112th Ave. It was a Saturday night and everyone closed up as normal. Shortly after the Club closed, a fire burst out in the bar area. It spread very quickly and left a lot of damage.



They thought that the fire may have been arsen due to the temperature and speed that it spread. This was never proven and the actual cause was not determined. Members pulled together and utilized their skillsets to help rebuild our home. We worked hand in hand with our vendors and we were open again within 6 months. This remained our home until 1983 when we moved into the building we currently call home. Westminster Lodge opened their upstairs bar room for our meetings while the rebuilding was taking place.



This sign currently hangs above the entry way to the dining room. It should not only serve as a reminder of a catastrophic event for our Lodge, but more importantly, a reminder of a membership that pulled together. A membership that overcame a hardship by becoming united as a Lodge, stronger as a family and respected each other. Without this, we would not be here today to celebrate 50 years.
