




Celebrating our 50th Anniversary - Paying our Mortgage

It was in the late 1980's and the Northglenn Elks had recently moved into the building we currently occupy on Irma Drive. Excitement was still high due to the fact that we finally had our own building. It had been decided that we would sell notes to our members to pay off the mortgage. The notes would pay 10% interest annually. At that time, it was less than we would pay a bank and much more than anyone would get through a conventional investment. We would pay the interest annually per the agreement between the Lodge and the members holding the notes. Soon after, the Lodge fell upon lean times and by the early 90's it had become necessary to sell additional notes to pay the interest due on the currently held notes.

This story starts in 1993 when newly installed Exalted Ruler Dennis Bloch was approached with the documents to sell additional notes against the building. When Dennis inquired deeper, he found that we had been selling notes to pay the interest that was due on the currently held notes. Instead of paying the notes off reducing our burden, we were selling more notes causing us to go deeper in debt. Dennis refused to sign the documents and began to search for a a better way pushing us down a different path.

Dennis went to the Auxiliary and then President (PER)Teri Huffman and her Officers. They understood the gravity of the situation and knew that our Lodge could not survive if we continued as we were. They agreed to conduct Bingo Sessions to help raise money that was to go directly towards the existing notes and interest. The Lodge Officers began to operate the kitchen with all proceeds going towards our home. Several events were set up with the proceeds going to the Lodge to help make our home our own. Through the years we held several raffles and events and finally, in 1999 we were able to host a mortgage burning ceremony.
