

Did you Know...

Army Engineers—Navy Seabees

An outstanding achievement of the Elks was the part they played in the recruiting campaign staged by the Army Crops of engineers and the Navy Construction Battalions. When for the first time the Army and Navy embarked on a joint campaign to obtain men skilled in construction. The Elks War Commission was asked by the Army and Navy to assist in this drive. The Elks was the only organization to participate in the campaign.

The Lodges displayed so much enthusiasm and efficiency that the required numbers of Army Engineers and Navy Seabees were obtained three months ahead of schedule. A letter written on October 8, 1943 by J.A. Ulio, Major General, Adjutant General Since the B.P.O.E. was the only civilian organization actively supporting this campaign, It is entitled to full credit for the success obtained.


