## Elk of the Month





# Eleventh Hour Toast Continued...

Last month we gave you a brief history of the Eleven O'Clock Toast. The great variety of 11 O'Clock Toasts, including the Jolly Corks Toast, makes it clear that there was no fixed and official version until 1906-10. Given our theatrical origins, it was almost mandatory that the pre-1900 Elks would be expected to compose a beautiful toast extemporaneously at will. Regardless of the form, however, the custom is as old as the Elks. This month I wanted to expand and present a couple of other toasts that have been presented throughout the years.

## The Original Jolly Corks Toast

Now is the hour when Elkdom's tower  
is darkened by the shroud of night,  
And father time on his silver chime  
Tolls off each moment's flight.  
In Cloistered halls each Elk recalls  
His Brothers where'er they be,  
And traces their faces to well-known places  
In the annals of memory.  
Whether they stand on a foreign land  
Or lie in an earthen bed,  
Whether they be on the boundless sea  
With the breakers of death ahead.
