

2024 Northglenn Elks House Rules

The following "House Rules" have been reviewed and adopted by the official governing body of the "Club" - to wit - "House Committee;" per Northglenn B.P.O.Elks No. 2438 By-Laws.

All portions of this facility shall be construed to be part of the "Club." To wit - Lounge, Dining Room, Game, Card and the Lodge Room when utilized as a part of the "Club."

While it is understood that a set of "House Rules" cannot be adopted that will appease each and every Member, it is felt that "House Rules" are in the best interest of our Lodge, our Club, the majority of our Members and for the good of the Order.

The indulgence of each and every Member is requested, encouraged and will be greatly appreciated by all.

- 1. The House Committee is the official governing body of the Club, and shall be responsible for the management and control of the Club together with the responsibility to enforce the House Rules.
- a.) The Board of Trustees shall appoint a Club Director; and they act on behalf of the House Committee.
- b.) The Club Manager shall act under the direction of the Club Director in the management of the Club. They shall have the authority and responsibility to enforce all House Rules (whether he/she be an Elk or not).
- 2. The Club Hours of Operation shall be at the discretion of the House Committee.
- 3. This Club facility is for the use and enjoyment of all current, paid up Elk Members in good standing and their guests.
- a.) All Elk Members are responsible for the actions of their guests. (The spouse of an Elk Member is considered to be a guest.)
 - b.) Visiting Elks and all guests are subject to these House Rules.
 - c.) Infractions of House Rules will be reported to the Home Lodge of visiting Elks.
 - d.) All visiting Elks must sign the Visitor's Register.
- 4. The cost of any willful or malicious destruction of, or damage, to any property of the Lodge or Club will be borne by the responsible party. (Elks Members are responsible for the actions of their guests.)
- 5. Members of the Northglenn B.P.O. Elks No. 2438 shall be extended the privilege of cashing checks not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00) in any one day period. Checks, in excess of this amount, must be approved by either the Exalted Ruler, the Club Director, the Club Manager, or any other Officer of the Lodge (providing none of the aforesaid persons are available for approval).
- a.) Check cashing privilege is limited to fifty dollars (\$50.00) for visiting Elks and their guests. Checks of all visitors, must be approved by either the Exalted Ruler, the Club Director, the Club Manager, or any other Officer of the Lodge (providing none of the aforesaid persons are available for approval).
- b.) All Elks Members must produce their current Membership Card number to cash a check; and sponsor Members must produce their current Membership Card to cash a check for a guest.
- c.) Check cashing privileges will be suspended to any person having returned checks in the Club until said checks are recovered with cash by the writer of same.
- d.) Check cashing privileges may be suspended and/or discontinued by the Club Director or the Club Manager to any Member for continued abuse of the check cashing privilege.
 - e.) There will be service charge of fifty (\$50.00) on all returned checks.
- f.) Any check not collected and paid with service charge within thirty (30) days of the date check is returned will be reported to the Board of Trustees. At that time the Member responsible for the check will be considered, as an Elk, not in good standing, and will have Club privileges revoked for one year or until the outstanding check has been claimed (whichever comes first).
- g.) If the Trustees are unable to make arrangement within seven (7) days of notification, as in Section (f) above, the check may be turned over to collections for further follow up.
- 6. No Elk Member or guest shall reprimand any employee or volunteer of the Club. Members and guests are encouraged to report an in-attention to duty, inefficiency, or discourtesy to the Club Manager or to a member of the House Committee.
- 7. Persons deemed to be intoxicated and/or disruptive may be refused service and/or removed from the Club.

More rules will be posted in next month's Banner. Copies of the Bylaws and House Rules are available through the Lodge Secretary (Tom Chambers).
