



2024 Northglenn Elks House Rules

The following "House Rules" have been reviewed and adopted by the official governing body of the "Club" - to wit - "House Committee;" per Northglenn B.P.O.Elks No. 2438 By-Laws.

All portions of this facility shall be construed to be part of the "Club." To wit - Lounge, Dining Room, Game, Card and the Lodge Room when utilized as a part of the "Club."

The indulgence of each and every Member is requested, encouraged and will be greatly appreciated by all.

- 8. "Conduct unbecoming an Elk" shall include personal conduct likely to bring reproach upon the Order and willful violation of House Rules. Profane, abusive, discrimination or obscene language, or other conduct unbecoming an Elk, is prohibited. This shall include by definition, sexual harassment as described in the sexual harassment policy. The Officers on Duty, together with all Members of the Lodge, shall enforce this rule at all times. Anyone violating this rule may be denied service, asked to leave the Club, and may subjected to disciplinary action by the House Committee.
- a.) Possession, consumption, or use of any type of Marijuana product on Lodge property is hereby forbidden by a Member; and will be considered "Conduct unbecoming an Elk." Also, Federal Law prohibits Marijuana. Our non-Elk guests and visitors must, likewise, obey our House Rules concerning the possession, consumption, or use of marijuana products while on our property.
- 9. No Lodge or Club property will be removed from the premises without approval of, and being signed out by the Club Manager or an authorized representative prior to such removal.
- 10. No soliciting, petitions, notices, advertising, subscriptions, or items for sale shall be circulated or exposed in the Club, except those with a direct association with the Club, Lodge, or Elks business.
- 11. Guns are not permitted on the property outside of your personal vehicle. Members and guest will not carry guns or weapons, of any type, while on the property of Northglenn Elks Lodge #2438. Members and guests carrying weapons should secure them in their vehicle prior to entering the Lodge.
- 12. We are committed to abiding by State and Local liquor laws and regulations. Our staff will be provided with adequate training for serving alcohol. We will communicate to all Members that the service of alcoholic beverages is a privilege, not a right; and each Member should consume responsibly. We will enforce a zero tolerance of overserving by our staff. A person deemed to be intoxicated and or disruptive may be refused service and/or removed from the Club.

The over service or consumption of alcohol as defined by local law or ordinance is strictly prohibited; this rule shall be applicable to all Members, Officers, and employees of the Lodge pursuant to Grad Lodge Statute 17.052.

More rules will be posted in next month's Banner. Copies of the Bylaws and House Rules are available through the Lodge Secretary (Tom Chambers).
