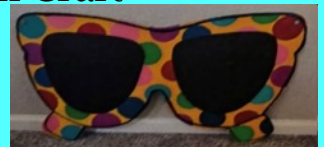

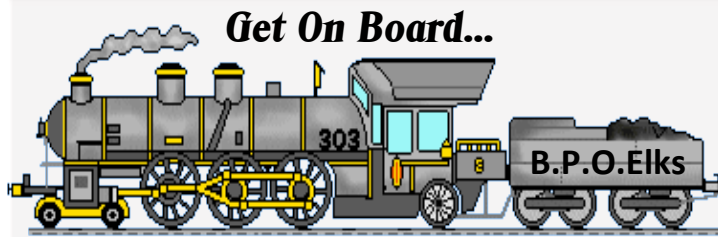

B. P. O. Elks and Flag Day

Patriotism has characterized the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks of the United States of America since the early days of the organization. Allegiance to the flag of our country is a requirement of every member. In 1907, the Grand Lodge of the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks designated, by resolution, June 14 as Flag Day. The Grand Lodge of the Order adopted mandatory observance of the occasion by every Lodge in 1911, and that requirement continues. The Elks prompted President Woodrow Wilson to recognize the Order's observance of Flag Day for its patriotic expression. But it was not until 1949 when **President Harry Truman, himself a member of the Elks**, made the proclamation that thereafter June 14 would be a day of national observance for the symbol of our country. It was through his Elks Lodge in Independence, Missouri, that President Truman got the idea for a national observance of Flag Day.

The Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks has made more than **12 Billion** in donations since we first started 154 years ago. Last year alone, the Elks donated approximately **\$300 million** in cash, gifts and time to make our communities better places to live. The Elks are one of the premier patriotic and charitable organizations in the United States of America. Annually, the Elks award college scholarships across the nation totaling more than **\$4.5 million**.

The Elks Community Investment Program will award nearly **\$15 million** towards enriching our communities. The Elks National Foundation also granted **\$10 million** to the state Elks associations through State Charities Grants, Special Project Grants and Bonus Grants, which help fund each state's charitable activities.

There are more than **1,900 Elks Lodges** across the country with a total membership nearing **800,000. Elks'** members must be American citizens who are at least 21 years of age and must believe in God. To learn more visit <https://www.elks.org>>www.elks.org.
