Wow is what I can say about Grand Lodge such an amazing time to be surrounded by all the great Elks. So on Wednesday July 2nd, I was tasked with voting on behalf of this wonderful Lodge.

2025-04—To authorize the issuance of electronic membership cards, allow the Office of the Grand Secretary to determine requirements, and require Local Lodges to recognize an electronic membership card in the same manner as paper cards . 2,502 YES, 456 NO . PASSED.

2025-05—To define what constitutes a Lodge Affiliate. 2,778 YES, 190 NO . PASSED .

2025-06—To clarify the suspension of the social privileges of a member applies to all social functions and social activities of the Order . 2,836 YES, 134 NO . PASSED .

2025-07—To clarify, if a Local Lodge adds the Secretary and Treasurer to the Board of Directors, the Lodge must ensure such action is consistent with its corporate documents . 2,779 YES, 164 NO .

PASSED.

2025-01—To make participation in the physical loss and crime coverage policy procured by Grand Lodge optional for Local Lodges and to require proof of alternative insurance coverage . 830 YES, 2,122 NO . FAILED .

2025-02—To allow a Lodge to satisfy the bond requirement for the Lodge Secretary through an outside insurance company . 845 YES, 2,120 NO . FAILED .

2025-03—To allow a Lodge to satisfy the bond requirement for the Lodge Treasurer through an outside insurance company . 872 YES, 2,093 NO . FAILED.



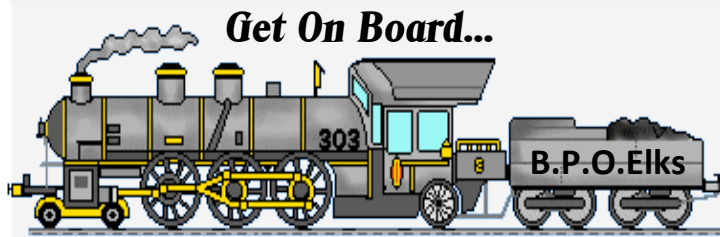
The 2025 Luau sponsored by the PER's turned out to be a great time. I would like to thank everyone who helped bring it together.

Elks National Foundation Scholarships

Since 1931. The Elks National Foundation has helped students recognize their academic dreams. Each year, we award more than \$3 Million in college scholarships to at least 850 outstanding, service-minded high school seniors.

Most Valuable Student: The Elks National Foundation will award 500 four-year scholarships to the highest-rated applicants in the 2026 competition.

Emergency Educational Grants provide undergraduate financial assistance to children of deceased or totally disabled Elk Members

Most Common and Popular Grant available is the Legacy Award to families of Elks Members

Legacy Awards are \$4,000 scholarships available to children and grandchildren of Elks members.

Who is Eligible: For the 2026 contest, any child or grandchild (or step-child, step-grandchild, or legal ward) of a living Elk who joined the Order on or before April 1, 2023, or a charter member of a Lodge that was instituted on or after April 1, 2023, is eligible to apply. The Elk must also be a paid-up member for the last two contiguous years through March 31, 2026. Great-grandchildren are not eligible.

*The applicant must be a high school senior.

*We have waived the standardized test requirement for the 2026 Legacy contest. You do not need to submit ACT and/or SAT scores.

*Students may apply for more than one ENF scholarship; however, they may win only one.

*Legacy Awards may only be applied to accredited US American schools, colleges or universities.

When do I apply: The applicant must apply online only. The 2026 Legacy Awards application deadline is February 2, 2026, 11:59 a.m. Pacific Time. NOTE: This is NOON, mid-day, Pacific time.

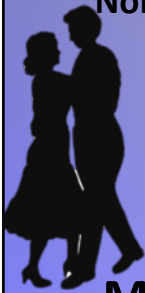

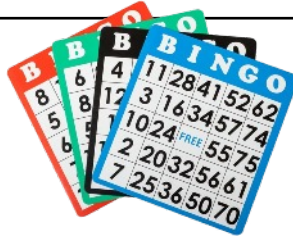

The Original Pledge of Allegiance

"I pledge allegiance to my Flag and the Republic for which it stands- one nation indivisible-with liberty and justice for all."

On September 8, 1892, the Boston based "The Youth's Companion" magazine published a few words for students to repeat on Columbus Day that year. Written by Francis Bellamy, the circulation manager and native of Rome, New York, and reprinted on thousands of leaflets were sent out to public schools across the country. On October 12, 1892, the quadricentennial of Columbus' arrival, more than 12 million children recited the Pledge of Allegiance, thus beginning a required school-day ritual.

At the first National Flag Conference in Washington D.C., on June 14, 1923, a change was made. For clarity, the words "the Flag of the United States" replaced "my flag". In the following years various other changes were suggested but were never formally adopted.

It was not until 1942 that Congress officially recognized the Pledge of Allegiance. One year later, in June 1943, the Supreme Court ruled that school children could not be forced to recite it. In fact, today only half of our fifty states have laws that encourage the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance in the classroom!

In June of 1954 an amendment was made to add the words "under God". Then-President Dwight D. Eisenhower said "In this way we are reaffirming the transcendence of religious faith in America's heritage and future; in this way we shall constantly strengthen those spiritual weapons which forever will be our country's most powerful resource in peace and war."

"I PLEDGE ALLEGIANCE TO THE FLAG OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA AND TO THE REPUBLIC FOR WHICH IT STANDS, ONE NATION UNDER GOD, INDIVISIBLE, WITH LIBERTY AND JUSTICE FOR ALL"
