Since the event began in 2018, it has been very popular – attracting several hundred people each year from six states and over 70 towns across Pennsylvania and New York. Last year, many people traveled up to 200 miles to attend the event, coming from Maryland, Minnesota, Michigan, Massachusetts, and other areas. This educational event is designed to celebrate all topics pertaining to Barclay Mountain, which serves as the backdrop for the event. Visitors can enjoy lectures, demonstrations, exhibits, music and food (see partial list of this year's participants to the right).

In order to offer free admission so the public can learn from and enjoy the history and heritage of Barclay Mountain, the museum is accepting sponsorships from businesses, organizations, clubs and individuals who have a particular interest in promoting and preserving the mountain or the fascinating history of its natural resources (coal, timber, natural gas) and the industries that have used them; its hunting and fishing opportunities; the conservation of its forestland; its geology and much more.

Proceeds above and beyond the expenses of this event will benefit the museum, including its building project, as it restores an 1896 hotel built with timber that was harvested from Barclay Mountain.

LHM is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization and tax receipt letters will be automatically sent to donors. Sponsors will be acknowledged according to the category chosen on the back of this form. Hemlock sponsors and above have the option to have the name of one family member who was associated with the mountain placed on the vinyl sponsorship banner the day of the event as a memorial or in honor. This could include coal miners, lumbermen, hunters, refuge keepers, game wardens, cabin owners, etc. This option is not available for Pine sponsorships.

Sponsorship submissions should be postmarked by April 18, in order to guarantee inclusion in print advertising beginning thereafter. Additional sponsorships will be accepted until June 1, but these will not be included in print advertising, only on the event banners.
