By the book: KBG syndrome is a rare genetic disorder caused by a variant on the ANKRD11 gene, associated with a spectrum of challenges, including developmental delays, cognitive disabilities, behavioral disorders, autism, seizures, hearing loss, skeletal anomalies, heart complications and gastrointestinal problems. Most people with KBG share at least some physical traits, including triangular face, heavy eyebrows, curved fingers and spine, and short stature.






KBG syndrome was named after the first initial of the last name of the 3 families first diagnosed. Draw or write what KBG means to you.












