SECTION 1: TACK & TURNOUT

£15 per entry; one rider per horse

Class will be judged on correct and well presented turnout of both horse and rider.

Riders will be fully responsible for the turnout of their horse. School horses to be booked through EC Pro classes 101-121 first come, first served. Solarium slots will be available to book the day before the show for bathing and advice will be available on turnout in the lead up to the show.

JUNIOR IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP

1st and 2nd from class 03 and any handlers aged 11-15 placed 1st to 6th in any other in hand class

IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP

1st and 2nd from all in hand classes (including eligible minis and juniors)

1st and 2nd from class 04 and any handlers aged 11-15 placed 1st to 6th in any other ridden class

RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP

1st and 2nd from all ridden classes except classes 01, 02, 03, and 08 (including eligible minis and juniors)

SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIP

All champions and reserve champions (in hand & ridden)

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The organiser reserves the right to cancel or amalgamate classes in the event of insufficient entries.
2. Exhibitors are requested to have their animals forward for judging on time. Where an animal is entered in more than one class, the organiser takes no responsibility if a clash occurs.
3. The judge's decision is final.
4. Parking will be on grass.
5. The organiser or any of its assistants or stewards will be in no way responsible for any loss, injury or damage that may happen to exhibitors or their assistants or other members of the public, or to any animal or property or to any vehicle brought into the showground or leaving the same.
6. Correctly secured British Standard Skull Caps / Riding Hats to current safety standards must be worn at all times when mounted.
7. Warm up must be in designated areas only.
8. The safety of all children showing animals is the full responsibility of their parent or guardian.
9. Judges will be entitled to breaks throughout the day. These will be announced.
10. We will try our best to keep everyone up to date with the schedule and announce classes. However it is the responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure they attend their class promptly.
11. Well behaved dogs allowed on short leads. The handler of any animal causing a disturbance or distraction to competitors may be asked to remove it.
12. Numbers must be worn.
13. Acceptance of the foregoing provisions will be a condition of entry.
14. Tack & Turnout entries will be as per the selected horse.
15. All other classes will be horsed by instructors. Rider requests will be taken into account wherever possible, but cannot be guaranteed.
16. Classes in sections 2, 3 and 4 will be judged on handling / riding of the horse and presentation of the rider. The presentation or confirmation of the horse will not be taken into account as we acknowledge these may be outside of the control of the competing rider. Riders must be clean and smartly dressed (shirt and tie) but we acknowledge not all riders will have a showing jacket available.
17. No horse/pony may compete in more than 4 ridden classes or more than 8 classes in total.
18. Riders and their parent / guardian must be fully responsible for horse prep and timely arrival at classes etc. through the day. Yard staff will be present if you get stuck but will not be able to provide full support.
