## \* Things to Bring:

## \* Circle Time:

- AM and PM snack (we provide)

## \* Toddler Grams

- Every day I will come home with a Toddler gram that tells about my day. It will tell you when and how much I ate, when I had a diaper change, if I need more diapers or wipes, and what fun things I did while you were away.

## \* Fun Throughout The Day

Our older toddlers will complete potty training. They will sit in a chair without a seat belt for crafts, snacks and lunch. They will drink out of cups with no lids. They will sit on a circle mat for circle time, reading times, and singing times. They will learn how to follow several directions, and sit for approximately 15 minutes at a time. They will continue to learn their letters, colors, and numbers. They will begin learning their addresses, phone numbers, and birthdates. They will be read to each day. They will be taken outside to enjoy sidewalk chalk and/or play in our play yard daily. They will remain in this area until they are approximately 3 ½ years of age.
