# From The Pastor's Desk

The Advent/ Christmas season is a season full of traditions. One of the traditions in our household is that we decorate for Christmas the day after Thanksgiving. It is always heart-warming to watch the excitement and anticipation as our children help set up the Christmas tree and hang beautiful ornaments on it, or place their stockings on the banister, or hang dazzling lights all over the house. But my favorite decorations are the nativity sets that beautifully depict the birth of our Lord and Savior and remind us of the true reason we celebrate.

I wonder, though, if we don't sometimes lose sight of that and place Jesus on the shelf like any other piece of décor to be absorbed into the background and forgotten until it's time to take Him down and dust Him off. It's easy to be distracted with all of the hustle and bustle that this time of year brings: shopping, wrapping, baking, visiting friends and family – none of which are bad per se – but do we have the same urgency and excitement to worship Christ as we do these things?

When Jesus was born, Mary and Joseph wrapped Him in swaddling clothes and laid Him in a manger because there was no room for them at the inn. The greatest event since creation to come upon the world had just occurred: our King, our Lord, our Savior and Messiah had just arrived in the flesh...and nobody had any room for Him. In today's culture, we have busied ourselves and filled our lives with so much "stuff" that many people still don't have room for Him; Jesus becomes an afterthought. "I'll read my Bible if I get the time." "I'll pray when I need something." "I'll give to the church if I have a few bucks left over." "I'll come to church if I don't have anything better to do on a Sunday morning."

Now, I know I'm probably preaching to the choir. Those of you reading this newsletter are probably among the faithfully committed Christians, which is why I would like to encourage you to shine all the brighter this Advent and Christmas season. We know what it looks like when a house is decorated for Christmas; we can drive past and see all of the colorful lights on display. Similarly, Jesus said "you are the light of the world. A city built on a hill cannot be hidden. Neither does someone light a lamp and place it under a bowl. Instead, they place it on its stand and it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven." (Matthew 5:14-16).

Jesus Christ is the True Light that illuminates the dark corners of the human heart and fills us with His radiance so that we would walk as children of the light (Ephesians 5:8). This Christmas, don't place your light under a bowl, but display it proudly on the mantle of your heart for all the world to see. Then, perhaps, every heart will begin to prepare Him room because they cannot help but be drawn to the light of Christ within us.
