FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

"Jesus...said to her, "woman, here is your son," and to the disciple, "Here is your mother." From that time on, this disciple took her into his home."

- John 19:26-27

It is interesting that of all the things that Jesus was concerned about and could have been concerned about while He was hanging on the cross, dying for the sins of humanity, He took the time to ensure that His earthly mother would be taken care of. We read in John's gospel that after Jesus' death, Mary became a part of John's household. She became like a mother to him, and he like her son. This is a relationship of mutual adoption and love that would characterize the early church and continues to characterize the true church today. No longer do we find ourselves as strangers following the same ideas, but we count ourselves as something closer - brothers and sisters; the family of God.

As we celebrate Mothers' Day this month, we give thanks for all of our earthly mothers who gave (and still give) so much of themselves - not out of compulsion or obligation, but out of their love for us. Truly, mothers are a model of the self-giving love of Christ. However, let us also not forget our spiritual mothers; those who have poured into us over the years and shown us an example of godly womanhood. Perhaps it was a Sunday School teacher, choir director, youth leader, friend or mentor. My guess is that none of us has to try very hard to think of someone who has been a spiritual mother to them throughout their life.

It has been said that "behind every great man is a great woman," but I am a firm believer that "behind every faithful Christian is a praying mother." If you are a mother and you have been praying for your children - don't stop! Even if your children are grown, never underestimate the power of your prayers for them. I would also encourage you to pray for God to send you spiritual children - those whose spiritual needs align perfectly with your God-given gifts and experiences.

I would also encourage each of us this month to take time to recognize the women in our lives who mean so much to us - without whom we would have fewer examples of God's love and grace. God bless our mothers; whether by birth or by baptism...we love you!





Small Group Bible Study




