The picture to the left is entitled, "Easter Morning, Dad stays home from Church." It was painted in 1959 by none other than Norman Rockwell. You can see the Mom and her three children all dressed up, carrying their Bibles and the Dad is kind of slinked down in his chair, reading the newspaper, trying to avoid eye contact with the son, who's looking at him. This picture is so poignant to me because it strikes a chord of truth. This was painted 64 years ago, and for how many American households is

this a familiar sight on Sunday mornings? All you have to do is modernize the clothing and furniture and give dad an iPhone and a flat screen TV, and this picture would be circulated all over Social Media by frustrated mothers with the hashtag #storyofmylife.

But what strikes me the most about this picture, (which may be difficult to see) is the expression on the boy's face. It's as if you can almost hear him thinking, "Why do I have to go to church if dad doesn't?" "Why should I care about God?" Author Jack Graham says, "It really disturbs me to see so many men spending so much passion and energy on things that do not ultimately matter. A large metropolitan area offers men many opportunities to invest their passion for life in their careers, homes, or even their cars. The problem is that they not only wind up spending their time in pursuits that are going to perish, but their children pick up on what really matters to them."

I do not write this to be hard on fathers, but rather to encourage us men to be the spiritual trendsetters of our house, our office, our neighborhood, and yes, even the church. 
