From The Pastor's Desk

"Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good. His love endures forever. [He] gives food to every creature. He provides food for the cattle and for the young ravens when they call. His pleasure is not in the strength of the horse, nor His delight in the legs of a man; the Lord delights in those who fear Him, who put their hope in His unfailing love." Psalm 136:1, 25; 147:9-11

The psalmist uses the imperative voice, imploring the believer to give thanks to God, because He is good. In the same way, hallelujah (חַיָּ וֹלְקְבֹּחַ or hallelu Yah), literally translated, means "praise ye the Lord!" It is an imperative command which invites the hearer to "say something good about God!" Praise in this way is a communal act; one person's praise invites another to offer theirs. Giving thanks should be a contagious witness to God's unfailing goodness and love.

As we come upon another season of Thanksgiving, let's strive to have a thankful heart which will ignite the imagination of all the ways God has been good to us. By living with an attitude of gratitude, let's invite people from every tribe, nation and tongue to give God the glory due His name.

Here is some "praise kindling" to get the fires of our thankfulness started:

- Faith (John 3:16)
- Family (I Timothy 5:4)
- God's Word (Hebrews 4:12)
- Love (I Corinthians 13:4-7)
- Salvation (Titus 3:5)
- Creation (Revelation 4:11)
- Provision (Matthew 6:26)
- Grace (2 Corinthians 9:8)
- God's plans (Jeremiah 29:11)

What else can you thank God for today? Sing His praises and tell all the world what He has done! Hallelujah!
