From the Pastor's Desk

"As the women bowed their faces to the ground in terror, the two men asked them, 'why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here; He has risen! Remember how He told you while He was still in Galilee: 'The Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and on the third day rise again.'" Luke 24:5-7

He is risen! He is risen indeed! That is the joyful proclamation we look forward to every Easter season. Of course, Jesus doesn't actually die and rise again each year; His death and resurrection was a once-for-all sufficient sacrifice. However, Easter is a time of celebration for those of us who trust in Jesus Christ and believe in His resurrection. The resurrection of Jesus was unlike any other event in human history. Not simply because Jesus died and came back to life; others had done that before and after Him. Elijah raised a Shunammite's son to life (2 Kings 4), Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead (John 11), Peter raised Tabitha (Acts 9) and Paul raised Eutychus (Acts 20). The uniqueness of Jesus' resurrection rests on three facts of Easter:

1.) Jesus was raised by His own power! Every other person who was raised to life could not do so by themselves. Indeed, every resurrection (including Jesus') was made possible by the Spirit of God who gives life. John 6:63 states, "it is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh is no help at all." However, since the Son and the Father are One (John 10:30), it can be said that the Spirit of God which proceeds from the Father also proceeds from the Son. Therefore, it is by His own Spirit that He was raised. Moreover, Jesus predicted His own death and resurrection (Luke 24:7), revealing that all of the events surrounding Easter were divinely orchestrated. Jesus knew what He was doing all along.

2.) Jesus defeated death permanently! Every other person who was raised to life eventually died again. These were done as signs that point us to the ultimate resurrection. Jesus not only raised to life, but He continues to live to this day! As Romans 6:9 states, "For we know that since Christ was raised from the dead, he cannot die again; death no longer has mastery over him." Jesus will never die again. And if we place our faith in Him, neither will we.

3.) Jesus' death and resurrection secures for us eternal life! The same Holy Spirit that raised Jesus from the dead lives in every believer, and because of that we can have confidence that we will have eternal life. "For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we will certainly also be united with him in a resurrection like his." (Romans 6:5).

These facts of the resurrection are as true as all the rest of God's Word, and if God said it, we can be sure of it as well. This is the good news that we stake our hope in – not just for this life, but for all of eternity. It is the greatest truth of all: He is risen!




