"He has made everything beautiful in its time. Also, he has put eternity into man's heart, yet so that he cannot find out what God has done from the beginning to the end. I perceived that there is nothing better for them than to be joyful and to do good as long as they live." (Ecclesiastes 3:11-12)

God has made everything beautiful in its time. The writer of Ecclesiastes reminds us that "for everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven." Spring is a visible reminder of this great truth; that seasons change and time marches forward, but God is the author and conductor of it all. There is something humbling about watching the beauty of nature in full bloom. It reminds me that I am not in control. I can till the soil, plant the seed, position it to receive maximum sunlight, water it every day, but ultimately, I can do nothing to make the seed grow. I cannot by force of will cause even a single flower to bud and blossom. God is the one who makes the flower beautiful in its time. Does this mean that my actions don't play a part in God's purpose for the flower? Certainly not. But every drop of water given to that seed is in reality an act of faith. The act of watering says, "I don't see what is beneath the surface, but I trust that in time God will make something beautiful." How often do our own spirits thirst for water? The circumstances of life have left us parched and our hearts threaten to dry up and harden like sun-baked soil. What we need is water - living water that flows from the heart of Christ. Jesus said in John 4:14, "but whoever drinks of the water that I will give him will never be thirsty again. The water that I will give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life." When we stay connected to Christ through worship, prayer, reading and studying His Word, fellowship with other believers and serving others, His living water flows through us and cultivates the seed of salvation in our hearts. He still does the work of salvation and sanctification, but we can participate through acts of faith. We may still have days where we lose sight of the bigger picture and can't see below the surface to what God is actually doing in us, but faith is trusting that He will complete the work that He began in you and make it beautiful in its time. Let's pray. Gracious God, I trust that You bring all things to fruition. You cause the flowers to bloom and clothe the lilies in splendor, yet how much more precious to You are Your children? Help me to trust in Your patient, guiding hand even when I can't see what's happening beneath the surface. Keep me steadfast in faith and firmly rooted in Christ – the source of living water. Amen.
