From The Pastor's Desk

"Where shall I go from Your Spirit? Or where shall I flee from Your presence?

If I ascend to heaven, you are there! If I make my bed in Sheol, you are there!"

- Psalm 139:7-8

Reverend Richard Halverson is credited with the saying, "you go nowhere by accident." In context, this was part of his weekly benediction to his congregation before dismissing them out into the world to do God's work wherever God placed them that week. No doubt, Psalm 139 was likely part of his inspiration for that benediction. In it, David reminds us that God is unmatched in His knowledge and wisdom. His omniscient gaze meets us wherever we find ourselves.

To some, this is a terrifying thought; to others, it brings great comfort. Depending on the state of one's character and relationship to God, He is either a cruel taskmaster, waiting for them to mess up, or a gentle Father, ready to dust them off and set them on the right path again. In truth, we all can feel a mix of both at times. This can lead to the false belief that our salvation is only as secure as our best days, and as fragile as our worst. So, we find ourselves questioning our standing with God, hoping beyond hope that we die on an upswing and God finds our efforts acceptable.

The reality, however, is that Christ draws the line of salvation below our best and our worst days. Because salvation is a gift of God's grace through faith, it does not rest on our undulating feelings and weak efforts, and that is cause for praise! Jesus said in John 10:27-28, "My sheep listen to My voice; I know them and they follow Me. I give them eternal life and they will never perish. No one can snatch them out of My hand." How comforting is that?! To know that Jesus, who is God incarnate - the One who sees and knows everything there is to know about us - cares so deeply for us and desires our salvation.

Does that mean that He is ambivalent to sin? Not at all! The mark of a true disciple, a true "sheep", is that we hear our Shepherd's voice and follow Him. **Just as you don't go anywhere in life by accident, you don't become anything in life by accident either**. Discipleship requires effort on our part in order to become more like Christ, day by day - not to earn our salvation, but because we want to follow our Shepherd's voice wherever He leads us. Let's determine this season to **grow** and to **go**, so that we might **show** Christ's love to the world.




<u>Life Chain - October 1, 2023</u>


