Keynote Speaker

Daniel A. Singer, MD, MPH, FACP



Dr. Daniel Singer is the Director for Countering Biological Threats at the National Security Council. He is an internal medicine physician with expertise in global health, health informatics, and health policy who has worked in multiple countries on five continents.

Dr. Singer began his public health career at CDC as an Epidemic Intelligence Service officer in 1999. He left the agency for a series of distinguished federal positions focusing on global health and the integration of science and policy. After serving as the Eighth Luther Terry Health Policy Fellow in the HHS Office of the Secretary, he joined the HHS

Office of Global Affairs and was assigned as the Senior Medical Policy Advisor in the U.S. Department of State's Office of International Health and Biodefense. Dr. Singer then was recruited to be Associate Director for Global Health Research and International Activities at the *Eunice Kennedy Shriver* National Institute of Child Health and Human Development, part of the National Institutes of Health. He returned to CDC in 2012, first to the CDC programs in Malawi and Mozambique and then as the Regional Director for Central Asia where he managed four CDC offices in Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, and Uzbekistan.

Dr. Singer is a Captain in the U.S. Public Health Service. Among his awards, he has received the Award for Distinguished Service from the Secretary of Health and Human Services, two Superior Honor Awards from the Secretary of State, and a Certificate of Commendation from the U.S. Surgeon General. In 2012 he was named U.S. Public Health Service Applied Public Health Physician of the Year.

Dr. Singer received his B.A. from the University of Pennsylvania and his M.D. from the University of Pittsburgh. He did his internal medicine residency at the University of Maryland and completed his Masters in Public Health in International Health at Johns Hopkins University. He resides in Washington, DC with his wife and three children.

Chester County Composite Squadron 1008 grew by 15 new cadets and 4 new senior members. In Cadet Programs, we had 10 cadets complete Wright Brothers, and 3 complete Mitchell. On the Senior side, we had 3 promotions to 2nd Lt and 1 promotion to 1st Lt.

We had a full year of activities for the cadets and seniors: the Helicopter Museum in West Chester; Winter Hawk, the FAA tower at PHL, the Wing Conference, JBMDL Air Show support, the Air Mobility Command museum in Dover, Kennett Square Memorial Day Parade, WWII Weekend in Reading, East Fallowfield Concert in the park, Cadet Conference, Army Heritage Museum in Carlisle, Penn Con Model Show, Wreaths Across America at FIG, and in-door rock climbing. Our Aerospace program was full with multiple rocket and model building sessions throughout the year. We were able to get a rocket launch with 28 cadets completing Redstone, 25 completing Titan, and 3 earning their Rocketry Badge. Three cadets also earned their STEM Badge. A partnership with Chester County Remote Controlled Aircraft Club allowed 7 cadets to get training in RC aircraft and 3 to solo.

The Gill Wilson Award

Senior Professional Development Level 5 Award



The Gill Robb Wilson Award is the Civil Air Patrol's (CAP) highest award for Senior Member professional development. It recognizes senior members who have dedicated themselves to leadership and personal development in the CAP.^[1] The CAP first gave this award in 1964 to honor the late Gill Robb Wilson. He is regarded as the founder of Civil Air Patrol, and served as CAP's first executive officer.

As members progress through the program, they complete five increasingly complex training levels. Each level requires the member to become more involved in CAP activities, master skills in one of 23 technical areas, and develop leadership ability. As they complete these levels, the member receives awards, chances for promotion, and selection for more important roles within CAP.

The final milestone is the Wilson Award. It is earned after receiving the Paul E. Garber Award. In addition, members must direct the training of fellow members in a variety of courses. They must also have served in command or leadership positions for at least three years. Finally, they must have completed CAP's capstone course, the National Staff College, or approved equivalent. Recipients of this award, along with other requirements, makes a member eligible to the grade of CAP Lieutenant Colonel.

As CAP's premiere award for senior member professional development, the Gill Robb Wilson Award should be presented by an Air Force or CAP general officer, an elected state or federal official, or other distinguished person.
