



## **Distinguished Guest**

#### **BRIGADER GENERAL BRUCE THOMPSON, (Ret.)** Chief of Staff, Delaware National Guard





**Retired Brigadier General Bruce Thompson was the Chief** of Staff, Delaware Air National Guard. He served as the principle advisor to the Commander of the Delaware Air National Guard for all Air National Guard issues. He was responsible for assisting the planning, directing and administering programs for approximately 1,100 Air National Guard personnel within the state. He was further responsible for providing trained, equipped and mission ready forces in support of federal mobilization requirements and state emergency operations. He developed plans, programs and policies in support of the Delaware C-130 Wing and maintained liaison with major commands and the National Guard Bureau. General Thompson received his commission through the Air National Guard Academy of Military Science in 1980. He earned his pilot wings in 1981 from Reese Air Force Base, Texas. General Thompson was an Instructor and Standardization/Evaluation Pilot for the C-130 Aircraft with 32 combat sorties and 197 combat support sorties. He served as Commander, 166th Airlift Wing and is a veteran of Operations Desert Shield, Desert Storm, Noble Eagle, Enduring Freedom and Iraqi Freedom. General Thompson is a command pilot with over 4,500 hours in the C-130A, C-130H2, T-37 and T-38.

Our activities today deepen our understanding of CAP's current situation and path into the future. To move forward, we will rely on everybody from the youngest cadet to the most experienced senior. Our dynamic community has been very busy this year – 37 cadets attended encampment and 13 attended NCSAs, 13 pilots flew over 320 hours, 3 squadrons attained Quality Cadet Unit Awards, and of course there was untold effort devoted to meetings and weekend activities. In all we include 16 cadet officers, 7 current pilots, over 2,000 emergency service qualifications, and 46 master-level specialties. 

# Cadet Promotions SPAATZ AWARD



THE GENERAL CARL A. SPAATZ AWARD is Civil Air Patrol's highest cadet honor. It is presented to cadets who have demonstrated excellence in leadership, character, fitness, and aerospace education. Cadets qualify for this prestigious award after devoting an average of five years to progress through sixteen achievements in the CAP Cadet Program. Along the way they develop self-discipline, a strong sense of personal responsibility, the ability to lead and persuade, and the foundation necessary for pursuing a career in aviation, space, or technology. The final step a cadet must complete to earn the Spaatz Award is a rigorous four-part exam consisting of a challenging physical fitness test, an essay exam testing their moral reasoning, a comprehensive written exam on leadership, and a comprehensive written exam on aerospace education. Upon passing the Spaatz Award exams, the cadet is promoted to the grade of cadet colonel. The Spaatz Award is named in honor of Carl "Tooey" Spaatz, the first Chief of Staff of the United States Air Force. One of the giants in the history of airpower, in 1929 Spaatz, together with another pilot, set an important flight endurance record of 150 hours and 40 minutes in the early days of aviation. During World War II, he commanded the Allied air campaign against the Nazis. In the Pacific Theater, the atomic bombing of Hiroshima and Nagasaki took place under his command. After retiring from the Air Force, General Spaatz served as the first chairman of the Civil Air Patrol National Board
