So google is your friend and told us that the river gate marina was less than a kilometre down stream just the other side of the bridge. A quick phone call was made and Jax from the marina said there were berths available for the night. After a quick conversation with the other boats telling them our plans, suddenly all 10 participants decided the marina was a great option!

So all boats secured in the marina we did what we normally do in the afternoon, happy hour on the jetty was had.

Saturday was windy and wet but we had a great trip up river into the city of Brisbane, stopping at the Botanical Gardens for morning tea and a walk.

Very good berthing facilities and the views of the city from the water were spectacular.

We then cruised up river a bit further before heading down stream to the Powerhouse at New Farm for a leisurely lunch amongst the many bars and restaurants to choose from. Again, the berthing facilities were great.

We then headed back to anchor in the river ready for a visit to Eat Street where you had to take you tender to shore.

Sunday morning we were joined by Highly Strung and Tilly, we decided to have a lazy day in the marina cleaning boats and doing washing etc.
