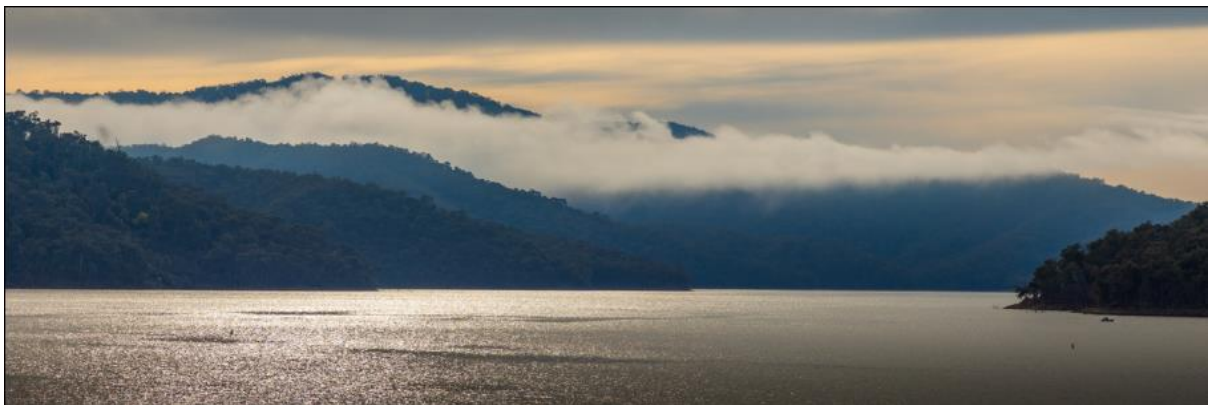


Eildon Cruise Report
