



History: On September 4, 1986, three accounting groups joined together to form the Philippine American Society of Certified Public Accountants of Los Angeles (**PASCPA - Los Angeles**). The unification of the Filipino Accountants Association (LA Chapter), the Filipino Accountants of Southern California, and the Philippine Institute of Certified Public Accountants of Southern California was made to recognize the importance of achieving greater positive impact on the community as one united force.

To this day, PASCAPA runs on this principle of unity by fostering cordial and harmonious relationships among members of the Society and community. The society currently has 200 members.

PASCAPA is a member of the National Council of Philippine American Canadian Accountants (NCPACA), which is an umbrella organization for Filipino CPA associations in the United States and Canada. A convention is held annually in different cities in Northern America, as an opportunity to network and update on accounting knowledge in our ever-changing accounting profession.
