
















































Case Studies



### The Billericay Project



Designing this bathroom came with a straight objective: Be bright, classy and elegant.

Our client wanted a chic walk-in shower with a seating area, so the first challenge was how to combine these two elements effectively. We knew our client didn't want the seat under the main showerhead, so we decided to introduce fluted glass screens on both sides of the entrance, to partition the enclosure into two separate zones. This allowed for a luxurious and spacious shower area on one side and gave us the freedom to install the seating on the other side, with a pencil handset for rinsing.

We also knew from the outset we needed to have a feature wall, one that would really pop, and the shower area was ideal for it. Using the back wall for the feature tile meant we were able to create the seating from the same tile and give it consistency. We didn't want the tiles fighting for prominence with any others we chose, so we looked to a muted grey stone effect for the rest of the floors and the walls.

By using brushed brass hardware across the suite instead of a chrome finish, we amplified the elegance significantly. The use of the double wall hung vanity unit in the natural looking Oregon Oak, the wall mounted taps and the wall hung pan gave the room the feeling of space and allowed light to move around the room more freely, helping achieve the bright feeling the client wanted.







#### The Ramsden Bellhouse Project

Selecting the right bathtub and colour scheme to create a focal point in this Mid-Century bungalow was key to our clients requirements, as they wanted something to complement the softer features of the property, but to also introduce the calming elements of nature.

These requests dictated our approach to the rest of the bathroom.

We chose a double ended bath with a more defined oval bathing area, accompanied by a contrasting marble effect porcelain tile feature wall, bringing in earthy green tones and the look of a natural stone dug out of the Aravali mountain range. We finished the bathing area off with brushed bronze pendant lights overhead to add a touch of luxury and relaxation.


The curved edges of the double basin continued this gentle approach, and the four drawers underneath ensured this bathroom met everyday functionality and provided plenty of storage.

The shower enclosure was intentionally designed to be understated, as to maintain the open and spacious feel of the room. The bespoke three quarter height dividing wall defined the shower area and also doubled up as useable wall space to accommodate the towel rail on the other side.



#### The Hutton Mount Project





This Neo-Traditional home in the heart of Hutton required a bathroom to match it's classic yet contemporary stylings.

In order to achieve this look, we paired a copper roll top bath alongside a walk-in shower, all with oil rubbed bronze brassware and fittings.

We combined this with shaker style furniture fronts as a nod to the traditional, and the addition of a counter top bowl added a unique and stylish feature to the design, further enhancing the overall look and feel of the bathroom.

By introducing wooden shelves into the arched alcoves, we've turned this feature from purely aesthetic to being practical at the same time. This now provides both storage and a natural element to the space, bringing in warmth and character.


The LED mirror adds a modern touch to the space while also providing practical lighting for daily tasks. The striking large format marble tiles with a hint of bronze perfectly complement the wooden floors and bronze brassware, tying the whole design concept together.
