

#### Agenda – Janice Phillips

#### 1. Admin report – Sanj Johal, Principal

- a) School goals engagement, belonging changing our language for example, instead of late slips, welcome slips. Welcoming in kids and happy to see them when entering late. "I can" statements are very important. Behaviour piece call out the behaviour, not the child. Sense of belonging for staff games event coming up. Treating subs/EAs as guests happy to have them. Kids are taking this to heart to support subs. Give subs a survey 5-6 questions and Sanj reviews it to get feedback.
- b) Sense of belonging celebrating differences. Talked about Diwali to the classes with a Gr 6 student. Another student connected to Japanese culture wants to talk about Japanese new year in January. Persian staff/kids to talk about Nowrooz. 2 teachers Natalie & Rochelle to do school spirit days planning pj days, hat days etc starting in January.
- c) Student/staff/parent surveys. Will look at sense of belonging.
- d) Code of conduct 3 r's respectful, responsible, resourceful thinking about changing to an acronym that aligns with wolf HOWLS 95% of staff support this. Div. 1, 2, 3 also 90% supportive. PAC Co-Chairs have reviewed and support too. Next steps will update district, then update website, then

- e) PBIS positive behaviour interventions and supports 3 tiered framework evidence based interventions for behaviour, learning, academics. More about changing adult behaviour. At the end of each month there is a draw for a pink slip connected to the 3 R's. go into a draw box and the office draws a name and they get called to the office to pick out a pencil, eraser, etc. Looking at better SWAG, maybe with our logos toques, wristbands, etc. Continuing the same system but with HOWLS. Classroom to intro own systems into the class connected to the school system.
