We have a congregational meeting coming up at 11:30 a.m. Sunday in the fellowship hall. Here's the agenda.

- 1) Elect Graham Reece onto the Church Council to hold the seat of Youth Representative.
- 2) Review our financial report and update the congregation on the new software and accounting standards report.
- 3) Present a Continuing Resolution to the congregation for vote and approval:

The Congregation of St. Stephen, on the advice of the Church Council, recognizes the need to revise the Buildings & Grounds position on the Council: that is, for one Council representative to be assigned to Buildings ministries and a separate member assigned to Grounds ministries. Each elected member will have voice and vote on the Council as a continuing resolution and not conflicting with the constitution or its bylaws.

- 4) Elect a member of the congregation to the Council to fill the vacancy resulting from the above resolution.
- 5) Continue the Open Forum discussions for ministries inside and outside of St. Stephen. For more on those discussions, look below!

... AND THEN THE OPEN FORUM

This Sunday, in our Open Forum discussion, we'll spend about 30 minutes total in three small groups. People can choose which group to attend. In case some are interested in more than one group, we'll keep notes to share.

The theme is Journey to Mission:

- One group will discuss avenues to interact with people outside of St. Stephen.
- A second group will discuss ways to interact with people inside St. Stephen.
- A third group will discuss a roadmap for compiling our own video testimonies – with people to write and record thoughts about St. Stephen and put them on a St. Stephen YouTube page.



The meeting will be held in the fellowship hall, and groups can break out into the conference room and office lobby.

UNITY, NOT UNIFORMITY: AN EXCERPT FROM PASTOR TOM'S SERMON

... Today, as we wade into our assigned lessons, we are reminded ... that it is a human desire to be uniform. *Uni* means having only one. *Form*, from the Latin *forma*, means shape or appearance. "Having only one form" is our desire to want to be ... just like everyone else.

But if Paul in the Ephesians texts wants us to remember anything, it is to know (or remember) that the primary call of people is to be in unity, not uniformity. He wrote to a congregation of Jesus followers that thought they all had to be the same.



This is a constant journey for us to reject this desire for uniformity and embrace the call for unity – because we think that in order to be in harmony, we must be the same. Like a team with matching uniforms, we love the appearance of uniformity, but forget that it's God's call for humanity to not be the same as each other (how boring!). And Jesus' followers ought not behave in the same ways as society behaves....


