Genesis 12:1-4a

Nicodemus was a Pharisee, learned and good, Just like we strive to be... ought to be... should

He lived by the rules and judged other's behavior Nicodemus went to Jesus not expecting a Savior

He had watched Jesus say and do the unexplained

Jesus had to come from God, but there were these other things

So Nic went at night, wondering was God cutting strings

God loving the world was a blessing Did that mean the unclean, surely Jesus was jesting

Nic, like many today, was afraid to know God in that way

Stuck, visiting at night and in confusion

Jesus was troubling, hard to understand Like God's call to Abram to leave his land Not just about leaving but going to be a blessing Lift up eyes, knowing you are kept and that help was coming

Jesus' words about being born anew Can be confusing, painful and yet still true

We know firsthand, life without God, is shifting sand

Today we learn the meaning of "having eternal life" Not something in heaven or hell

Eternal life with us now... even in a world of strife Here in this place and out there too

God call us to see Jesus... making all things new.
