ORDER

This matter coming before the Court for hearing on Plaintiff's request to extend the Temporary Restraining Order ("TRO") and Plaintiff's Motion for Special Order Authorizing Alternate Service, counsel for Plaintiff and counsel for Mr. Baca present on Zoom, the Court being fully advised in the premises,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Plaintiff having shown good cause for extending the TRO, the TRO entered against Defendants on December 18, 2025, extended on December 29, 2025, and extended on January 8, 2026, is extended to 5:00 p.m. central standard time on January 23, 2026;
2. The TRO is not extended and is voluntarily dissolved with respect to Coinbase Deposit Wallet No. 0x36a27D8C800508e97e3182F905922F92098c3808 ("Coinbase Deposit Wallet") owned by Andrew Baca. The freeze on the Coinbase Deposit Wallet and any other financial accounts of Mr. Baca are lifted, effective immediately. In addition, Plaintiff shall provide a copy of this Order immediately to Coinbase notifying it of the dissolution of the TRO regarding the Coinbase Deposit Wallet identified above.
3. To the extent that Mr. Baca can be deemed John Doe, such claims are voluntarily dismissed as to Mr. Baca only.
4. Paragraph 25(c) of the TRO Order issued on December 18, 2025 is modified to delete references to banks, trading exchanges, investment firms and other financial institutions and shall now read as follows:
 - a. Additionally, all persons who receive actual notice of this order (including the aforementioned exchanges, Defendants, and each of their respective agents, or

anyone acting or purporting to act on their behalf) are hereby prohibited from withdrawing, selling, transferring, conveying, encumbering, moving or otherwise altering the assets located within the cryptocurrency wallets or cryptocurrency trading accounts identified above, whether such assets are located inside or outside the United States of America.

5. Plaintiff's Motion for Special Order Authorizing Alternate Service is continued to January 22, 2026;
6. Unless otherwise extended, the TRO shall expire on January 23, 2026 at 5:00 p.m. central standard time. This matter is set for a status on Plaintiff's request to extend the TRO on January 22, 2026 at 9:30 a.m. via Zoom using the Zoom credentials below.
