Tile Purchase Application

The Alpine Veterans Wall of Honor is located on The Alpine Club grounds at 1830 Alpine Blvd., Alpine CA.

The Alpine Veterans Wall of Honor pays tribute to men and women who served in the armed forces of the United States of America. To be eligible for a tile on the Veteran's Wall of Honor, veterans must have served honorably or be currently serving. A veteran is someone who, at one point in their life, wrote a blank check made payable to the United States of America for an amount up to and including their life.

The submitting applicant for the purchase of a tile declares that the veteran for whom the tile is being purchased meets the criteria above. Applicant also declares that he/she has read what veteran data is allowed, listed below.

The cost of each tile is \$125.00, which includes engraving. Tiles are approximately 4 inches by 12 inches. Engraving is limited to three lines of 22 characters. A space counts as a character.

Second and Third Lines: Any combination of Branch of Service; Era served (WWII, Korea, Vietnam, etc.); Dates of Service; Rank; POW, KIA.

PLEASE INCLUDE COPY OF DD214 OR EQUIVALENT PROOF OF SERVICE AND YOUR PAYMENT.
