CALL TO ORDER (motion- seconded)

The meeting was called to order at 8:32 AM on June 28, 2026.

REVIEW MINUTES OF LAST MEETING

Expenditures for the 2026 Williamsburg reunion are not yet compiled, but will be provided to the treasurer when available. There were questions about the seed money needed for planning the reunion. Leslie Stratton stated that \$5,000 seed money was sufficient this year. 10.000 is anticipated to be returned to the fund. Tanner Mitchell moved to accept the Treasurer's report. Dan S. Sundt seconded the motion and it was approved unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS

1.Scrapbooks

Clint Sundt, Sundt Family President, discussed the needs for the family scrap books. A member of each tribe is responsible for updating, storing and transporting that tribe's individual scrapbook to each reunion. The scrapbook keeper for each tribe was noted for the record:

Leslie Stratton maintains the family history which was originally compiled by her father, then passed to Dick Sundt who created a paper copy of the document in 1997. She uses a family tree computer program to update the records. She encouraged the family members to send narratives about their lives to add to the book.

Dan S. Sundt brought up the need for a family historian. His mother Dolores had a whole room of her house dedicated to the family scrap books which she maintained and updated meticulously. Jacqueline Sundt and Sharon Campbell have been working on organizing photos for the reunion scrap book, which hadn't been updated since 2012, but they were not able to get all the photos in the books before the reunion. Sharon plans to get together with Jacqueline in the near future to update the books. Nicole Sundt suggested that since Clint Sundt is now retired, he could take on the special project of updating the family reunion scrap book. She nominated him for the task as historian, Jeff Isaacs seconded the motion, which was unanimously approved. Clint accepted on the condition that he be allowed to tell the stories of each reunion on his own terms.

A discussion followed about the possibility of linking Leslie Stratton's family history document on the VarSlekt website. Lisa Campbell stated that she would not agree to having the information publicly accessible due to the possibility of identity theft with birth dates and maiden names easily identified. Christian Sundt pointed out that with new laws being passed, it will continue to be easier for fraudsters to steal identities. Leslie Stratton asked what the Cyber Committee had discussed since the last reunion, Tanner Mitchell noted that the committee has not yet met. Dan Sundt moved to make the password protected PDF of the family history available to family members by request via email. Ashley Eubank seconded the motion which was approved unanimously. Family members can request a digital copy of the book by emailing Leslie at strva38-home1@yahoo.com.

Deanna Jordan suggested the need for each family to scan the pages of their tribe's scrap book so that a digital copy is preserved and available to share with family members at large. Joann Johnson stated that she did so over the course of a week with her Iphone and a tripod. Erin Mitchell made a motion to have each tribe create a digital copy of their scrap books. Debbie Denis seconded the motion which was approved unanimously.

- Jim and Betty Constand- will continue in role
