Introduction

The year 2025 was transformative for Saath Saath Foundation, marked by deepened community engagement, strengthened CSR partnerships, and impactful educational and environmental interventions. Our work spanned multiple villages, tribal schools, and economically vulnerable communities, with a strong focus on empowering students, enhancing rural infrastructure, and encouraging sustainable practices.



Through our hands-on approach and consistent field presence, we ensured that every initiative addressed real on-ground needs. This report highlights the comprehensive efforts undertaken across Maharashtra, including Jambrung, Pimpalpada, Malegaon, Borivali, and other tribal belts.

Key Highlights of 2025

- Introduced advanced digital literacy and work-from-home training for rural youth.
- Deployed multiple water purification systems across tribal schools.
- Launched 'Project Silae'—a livelihood program for women and youth.
- Provided solar-powered devices to 50 extremely needy families through CSR partnerships.
- Conducted environmental awareness, waste segregation, and plantation drives in multiple villages.
- Sponsored bus fees for 9 underprivileged Adivasi students ensuring educational continuity.
- Distributed umbrellas and stationery in 5 ZP schools, benefitting hundreds of children.
- Donated science laboratory equipment to strengthen STEM learning at PNP School.
- Organized movie-based value learning sessions for schoolchildren.



Education & Skill Development Initiatives

1.PNP School – Zoho Awareness & Work-from-Home Capability Program

Designed to empower students aged 18+ with digital skills that open doors to remote employment. This program introduced youth to modern workplace tools, communication platforms, and productivity practices.

2.Project Silae at PNP School, Jambrung

Launched to empower rural women and young girls with tailoring skills, ‘Project Silae’ witnessed enthusiastic participation. Multiple batches were trained, enabling livelihood creation and enhancing household income potential.



3.Support for 9 Underprivileged Adivasi Students

Transportation challenges often hinder school attendance. To address this, the Foundation sponsored bus fees for nine students throughout the academic year.

4.Laboratory Equipment Donation

Science learning received a major boost at PNP School through the donation of essential lab equipment, courtesy of our supporters Path of Bliss. Students now have hands-on access to practical experiments.



5.Educational Film Screening – *Elizabeth Ekadashi

Led by volunteer Mrunmai Patil, this session used cinema as a powerful tool for value-based learning. The film inspired discussions on responsibility, creativity, and ethics among students.



6.Stationery Support for ZP Schools

In collaboration with Ariane and Pagaria Foundation, notebooks, pens, and educational materials were distributed, encouraging better academic engagement.

7.Snake awareness workshop

our dedicated coordinator (samadhan) has successfully conducted a snake awareness workshop at khairmata mandir and Jambrung.



Infrastructure & Water Security Support

1. Eureka Forbes Water Purifier at Pinglas Tribal School

With clean drinking water being a fundamental need, the installation of a purifier significantly improved the health and hygiene conditions for children.



2. Safe Water Initiative at Bhaliwadi Ashram Shaala

Another water filtration system was established to ensure that students have daily access to hygienic and safe drinking water.

These initiatives help reduce waterborne diseases and improve overall well-being, especially in remote tribal communities.

CSR Partnerships & Community Outreach

1. Rotary Club of Bombay Bayview Charitable Trust (President: Sunil Devnani)

Played a pivotal role in supporting awareness campaigns, community upliftment, and resource distribution across villages.

2. Solar Torch, Bulb & Charger Distribution (50 Units)

Supported by Bajaj Electricals Employee CSR Fund, we distributed solar-powered devices to extremely needy families. These devices now serve as reliable sources of light and energy in areas with limited electricity. Our dedicated coordinator Samadhan has himself trekked to Bhimashankar and has met few Adivasi tribes for solar torch distribution.

3. Umbrella Distribution in 5 ZP Schools

Ensured that students attending schools during the monsoon season remain safe, dry, and comfortable.



4.Stationery,Classroom Support & Engagement Activities

Through various CSR partners, schoolchildren received academic support materials, improving their educational experience.

5.visit to observation home

Interns of our NGO visited the Juvenile Justice Board (JJB) and Child Welfare Committee (CWC) in Raigad district to gain practical insight into India's child protection system.

At the JJB, interns learned about the legal processes for children in conflict with the law and the focus on rehabilitation. At the CWC, they understood procedures for children in need of care and protection, including rescue, counseling, and reintegration.



Officials highlighted key child rights, the importance of inter-agency coordination, and the challenges faced in safeguarding vulnerable children.

The visit helped interns connect theory with field realities and strengthened their understanding of child rights and protection mechanisms.



Environmental Sustainability Projects

1. Large-Scale Plantation Drives

Conducted across Pimpalpada, Saraewadi, Borivali Village, and Malegaon. Native plant species were introduced to improve local ecosystems.

2. School Campus Beautification & Exterior Wall Painting

Encouraged children-friendly, vibrant environments that inspire learning.

3. Environmental Awareness Campaigns

Sessions focused on biodiversity, climate change, sustainable living, and conservation practices.

4. Waste Segregation Workshops

Students and villagers were trained to separate wet and dry waste, reducing environmental pollution and encouraging responsible waste disposal habits.

These efforts are foundational in developing eco-conscious communities and instilling values of sustainability in younger generations.

Micro-Level Community Impact

Saath Saath Foundation's philosophy is rooted in micro-level interventions. Rather than broad, generalized programs, every project is designed to cater to specific local needs.

We work village-to-village, school-to-school, and family-to-family, ensuring that assistance reaches the exact individuals who need it most.
