- The Eddington Bedrock: from Christie to Greiner to Gibbons

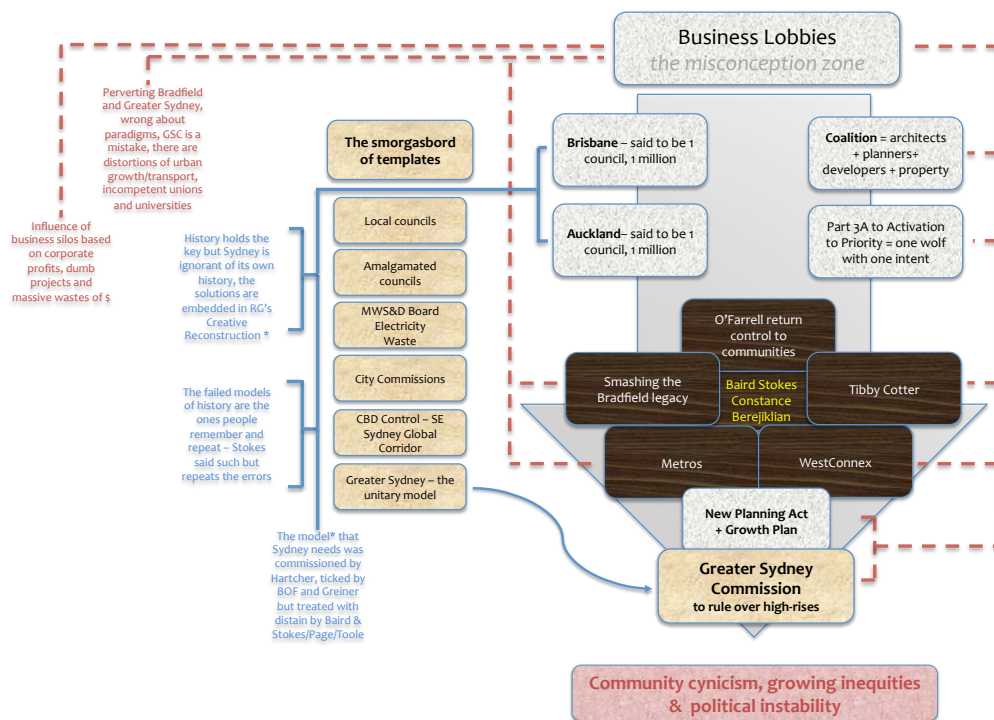
and other bits and pieces, all rejected by governments, leaving me with a taste for reform equal to Sir Thomas Hughes'.
