Thank you for granting me brief audience. Understanding that time is our most priceless and personal asset, I respectfully take a moment to introduce myself. I am Mr. Frank P. Wood, and I am the former owner, of the now extinct, Ironwood Construction, Incorporated out of Medina, Ohio. My cause for contacting you is a *Wicked Injustice*, and I - my family- we need your help.

Many years ago I applied to your office for assistance. At that time, I did not have the evidence or the education to properly present myself. Having dug deep, I have remedied that situation.

To prepare a proper presentation, in 2018 I wrote an Affidavit/Book, appropriately titled, A Blueprint for Wrongful Imprisonment ("Blueprint"). Indeed, I am Author and Affiant. Those who believe in me published it at www.freefrankpwood.com. A righteous movement.

Once on site, the Blueprint can be downloaded in the form of nine (9) consecutive *Google* files. It is 877 pages in length, and better than 80% of it is typed double-spaced for easy reading and legalities. What more, there are 86 Exhibits, save one (1), that are solely comprised of State,

Court and public records. The Exhibits account for 329 of those pages¹. Highly detailed and easy to follow, the Blueprint also contains a full <u>Table of Contents</u>, <u>Exhibit List</u> and <u>Works Cited</u> pages for easy referencing².

The project was an arduous and taxing task in this environment: an environment that is at the opposite end of the spectrum of being conducive to my goals. Armed with sheer will and determination: a mindset two (2) notches above tenacious, I wrote it in the form of a story (chapter by chapter), a trial, an educational tool, and an affidavit. Designed to teach *Patriotic & Taxpaying Americans* about the broken judicial system, and educate them on what the law actually declares³, it contains every legal and ethical violation committed by Court, State and alleged witnesses that I could find.

The Tenth Man Rule⁴

When ten people receive the same information, and nine out of those ten interpret that information and arrive at the same conclusion, as a precaution against error, it is the duty of the tenth man to start digging under the presumption that the other nine are wrong.

From the inception of the deliberately misinformed and misguided investigation, to securing a sham indictment, to the Prosecutor telling the "cynical" Jury to "find him guilty" and that they

"can feel good" about it (and the Trial Court showing them how), I have reverseengineered every element of my wrongful conviction⁵. Further, I have proven that two (2) perps run free, a State-proffered

Truly, a monumental project for an incarcerated pro se litigant.

Before proceeding, I must inform you that the "cynical" Jury possessed a Court-elected Juror who was "molested in [her] youth". The Jury was a major issue with my Wrongful Conviction. The Trial Court's manipulations and persuasions of this particular Juror resulted in Jury Tampering and Structural Error. One could go so far as declaring *in subsidium*. In this light, or dare I say 'shadow'?

Everyone is entitled to a fair and public hearing by an independent and impartial tribunal, in the determination of his rights and obligations and of any criminal charge against him.

Supporting my web site, those who believe in me have opened Free Frank P. Wood on Facebook. Designed as a public information page, we are currently working on expanding content and applications. Lately, we have been marketing the Facebook page to the public and media via boosts⁸ in several Ohio cities, and will continue to do so. Many of those who did this to me are readily aware of both sites. Deeply unnerved, several of them have complained to authorities only to be ignored, and some have closed their social media accounts. Yes, the flatiron is hot. Their mettle will fold.

For your apprisal, in the past, I have applied for assistance through the Ohio Innocence Project on two (2) separate and distinct occasions. After lengthy invests, they have never contested my innocence, as I have seen them do others. In fact, they require either DNA, new witness, or recanted testimony to reopen⁹. Unfortunately, they want the smoking gun. Why? Because most innocence projects seem to be afraid of articulating the litigation necessary to combat the social stigmatism attached to a sex case. Hence, the Blueprint was necessary to reduce legwork and expenses, and promote a greater understanding. Something the populace is in desperate need of.

To aid in the decision-making process, in the Blueprint you will find (Exhibit-19: Letters to Ohio Innocence Project) and (Exhibt-36: Ohio Innocence Project (OIP): Application: March 10, 2015). Perhaps these documents will answer questions already forming in your analytical minds.

Directly behind this letter of introduction you will find a completed Exoneration Project Intake Application, and an Addendum to EP Intake Application). As the Addendum mimics your Application Section-by-Section and Item-by-Item, I utilized { } for cross-referencing the numbered Items within. It is a lengthy but necessary presentation. You see, this case contains two (2) unrelated allegations and covers a span of many years. What more, the complexities of this case left me with no choice but to untie the Gordian Knot. I had to be meticulously thorough.

Within the Addendum, although the Blueprint is cited most, I do cite the affidavit of accusation from my web site. This document is not only a condensed version of the Blueprint and case, internal (Exhibit-A) is a copy of my materially altered and incomplete Trial Record. I have enclosed a copy of the (R.C. § 2935.09 & .10 Affidavit of Accusation; Ronald R. Stanley; March 5, 2020), along with internal (Exhibit-E: Affidavit of Verity and Confinement; Frank P. Wood; March 4, 2020), for convenience.

In maintaining transparency with your Team, I will publish this letter, the Application, and Addendum on my web site. A letter addressing the Public will precede the documents to show that, whether you help me or not,

I will fight this Insolent Injustice until Hell freezes over, and then I'll fight it on the ice.

Continuing, I was not allowed to testify, despite repeated demands. And, as Lead-Counsel failed to subpoena a single witness, my Expert Witness: M. Douglas Reed, Ph.D.¹⁰, was only permitted to testify *voir dire*. No, the Court-declared "cynical" Jury never heard any evidence on my behalf. Since

This also reveals why *Pre-Trial Media Character Assassinations* should be declared unconstitutional as a direct violation of Due Process and Equal Protection¹¹.

With that said, during the Covid-19 lock-down of the prison, an activist group: Change Starts With Us Ohio¹², recorded me over the prison phone system and broadcasted me on YouTube¹³, on a weekly basis, for several months. They gave me a voice, and I remain grateful. Now we are considering a podcast.

After all I have been through, I do declare that Society needs to go back to the days of Ancient Rome and Cicero in at least one (1) aspect. Yes, when people had to pay to prosecute their motivationally driven allegations. *Trust & Believe*, there would be a lot less innocent people in prison.

In closing, upon review, you will see that there are various grounds to reopen my case, e.g., witness, jury, and document tampering; a RICO Contract; speedy trial and *Miranda* violations; suppressed evidence; illegal search; Court-acknowledged and State-utilized perjury; bolstering; vouching; in subsidium; and the like. None of these have been litigated on appeal and will bear good fruit in a § 1983 filing. Yes, I have been busy.
