Scholarships will be awarded without regard to gender, race, religion, national origin, or economic status. The recipients may accept any type of other financial assistance. Scholarship monies will be sent directly to the recipient by August 1 with evidence of enrollment. Any scholarship recipient who does not enroll at an accredited college, university or trade school by the following semester forfeits their scholarship (January 2026).

- Scholarship awards will be presented at the Fox Tech Alumni Scholarship Fund Red & White Gala to be held on Saturday, December 28, 2024, at 7 pm held at The Red Oak Ballroom located at the Norris Conference Center, 618 NW Loop 410, #207A, San Antonio, TX 78216.
- 3. Official written notification to the student and high school will follow.
- 4. Scholarship money will be sent directly to the scholarship recipient.

When is the application deadline?

The completed application must be submitted by **Monday, October 18, 2024**, and turned in with a copy of the student's transcript to the Counseling Department.
