


#### **Planners Present Intersection Options**

County transportation planners presented traffic stats and future options on the Newberry Hill at Eldorado intersection at the May 1 meeting of the CK Community Council. Considered superior to a stop-lighted intersection for safety and traffic flow, a roundabout is considered the current leading solution. Further research and community outreach will lead to a final decision in the months ahead. The roundabout option as the most ideal option is 'unlikely to change,' said transportation department's Melissa Mohr in a conversation with HP2. The detailed reconfiguration process will also include survey work, permitting and real estate acquisition, and has an estimated completion date of 2030. Funds are not currently earmarked or available for the project, which, at current property tax rate levels, is disturbing, especially considering the Blue Fern Development plans (see below) were approved by commissioners in 2021.
