### Abstract Submission Terms and Conditions

- LCA receives only electronic submissions.
- All submissions should be emailed to [louisianacommunication@gmail.com](mailto:louisianacommunication@gmail.com).

- The first page of all submissions should be a cover page that has information about all presenters' names, affiliations, positions, and contact information (email addresses required)
- The cover page should have a clear indication to **which division among the 6 LCA divisions** you are submitting and **which form your presentation will be**.
- An abstract should have a clear structure with the purpose of the study/session, theoretical framework, main arguments, and/or discussion/talking points—as appropriate.
- **The optimal length of each abstract is about 300 words.**
- When submitting an abstract from a collaborative work, the submitter will be the point of contact and communication for that submission. Additional co-authors or presenters listed will not be notified directly in communication, but appear in the program. It is the submitter's responsibility to forward information and messages to other co-authors/presenters or other relevant parties.
- An individual cannot submit or be involved in more than 3 abstracts.
- All presenters and panelists must be at least 18 years old.
- Submitted abstracts must be in their final form.

## Graduate School Affair

All graduate schools are welcome to be a part of the graduate school affair. As this year's conference will be a virtual conference, if a graduate school sends materials to distribute to the LCA members, the organizer will forward the materials to the LCA members on behalf of the graduate school.
